



Adaplo/Magento2 Extension Installation Guide

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Installation

1. Component Manager

Using Component Manager is the official way for magento plugin installation.

Note: If the previous step doesn't work, proceed to the manual installation

2. Manual Installation

Manual installation is faster than installation by Component Manager. Also your shop won't be offline during it. On the other hand it requires admin access to your Magento server.

How to install:

1. [Download the zip file](#)^A that contains adaplo's plugin for Magento2
2. Unzip the contents to the following folder on your server:
<magento_installation_path>/app/code/.
3. Execute the following commands^B:
 - php <magento_installation_path>/bin/magento setup:upgrade
 - php <magento_installation_path>/bin/magento setup:static-content:deploy

Notes:

A. You can find the latest version of our extension from <http://tmp.adaplo.com/live/m2/adaplo.zip>

B. remember to execute the commands as the user account of the web server. (Usually is the www-data)

Recommended

It's a good practise after every installation of a new extension to flush the cache. Here's how to do it:

1. Go to your "admin panel -> stores -> cache management"
2. Click "Flush Magento Cache"
3. Click "Flush Cache Storage"

Extra configuration

After the installation in your admin panel you can configure the product's brand attribute if you are using a custom attribute. Also you can provide a custom product feed if you don't want to advertise specific products.

General

Brand Attributes [store view] Use plugin's default ▼
Attribute for brand. By default the extension checks for the 'manufacturer' attribute but if you are using a custom attribute for that purpose select it from the list above.

Product Feed URL [store view]
By default the product feed is automatically created and you just have to leave this field blank. But if you want to exclude some specific products from your product feed then you have to create your own and put the url in the field above.

Cron Requirements

If you run your own cron scheduler be sure to include the following:

- adaplo_handshake (every 15 minutes)
- adaplo_write_product_feed (every 12 hours)
