

Who Viewed This Also Viewed

Installation manual

To install the extension follow the instructions below:

- 1) Backup your web directory and store database
 - Get the Who Viewed This Also Viewed name and version in your Marketplace account:
Login to Magento Marketplace with the username and password you used to purchase the Who Viewed This Also Viewed extension;
 - Enter the My Purchases section: **Your name (top-right corner of the page) > My Profile > My Purchases;**
 - Find Who Viewed This Also Viewed and click **Technical details.**
- 2) Copy the provided component name and version in order to update your composer.json file.

Note: We advise you to use the latest version of our extension.

- 3) Update your composer.json file:

- Open the root Magento directory on your server and send Composer the following command:

```
Composer require <who_viewed_this_also_viewed>:<version>
```

- 4) At the Composer request, enter your Magento marketplace credentials (public key - username, private key - password).
- 5) Make sure that Composer finished the installation without errors.
- 6) Flush store cache, log out and log in the backend again.

The Who Viewed This Also Viewed extension is now installed and ready for work.

The Who Viewed This Also Viewed extension requires cron daemon setup and running.

Every time cron launches, customer sessions are analyzed for the most frequently viewed products. Based on this data, the module then automatically composes relevant product lists as recommendations.

Set up cron

If you have already configured cron jobs for your Magento installation then you can skip this step. Read the following instructions on setting cron job for your Magento store: [Magento user guide](#).

Generally it would be enough to run in SSH console of your server:

```
crontab -e
```

And insert the following line:

```
*/3 * * * * php -c <ini-file-path> <your Magento install dir>/bin/magento  
cron:run  
*/3 * * * * php -c <ini-file-path> <your Magento install dir>/update/cron.php  
*/3 * * * * php -c <ini-file-path> <your Magento install dir>/bin/magento  
setup:cron:run
```

Don't forget to confirm saving request when exit.
