

Magento 2: Easy Frontend HTML Dynamic Sitemap

Features:

1. This extension will provide Front end HTML sitemap pages for products, categories and CMS pages. (Default system generated URLs will be

**http://YOUR_SITE_BASE_URL/sitemap/product/
http://YOUR_SITE_BASE_URL/sitemap/category/
http://YOUR_SITE_BASE_URL/sitemap/page/**

2. Extension will be plug and play just after installation sitemap URLs can be access from frontend.
3. If merchant don't want to show any specific Page, Category or Product in the sitemap. They can add data in System Configuration Settings.
4. Merchant can create custom CMS page and if doesn't want the default generated one.

How To Use:

1. Install the extension.
2. Do the Setup Upgrade
3. Flush and Refresh the Cache from system->Cache Management
4. Sitemap URLs will be auto generated by the system and will be listed out in **Store->Configuration->AKHILG>Sitemap** (Please refer screenshot)
