


# Getting Started

## Create an Algolia account

1. Create your [Algolia](#) account. The [sign-up wizard](#) will guide you through Algolia's onboarding process. Pay extra attention to choosing your Algolia datacenter. Select the one which is the closest to your datacenter.
2. Once you are logged into dashboard, get your Algolia credentials from the "Credentials" left-menu.

# Install the extension

1. Install the extension via [modman](#) by:  
\$ cd /path/to/your/magento/directory  
\$ modman init  
\$ modman clone <https://github.com/algolia/algoliasearch-magento.git>
2. In your Magento administration navigate to **System > Configuration > Catalog > Algolia Search** administration panel.
3. In **Credentials & Setup** tab configure your Algolia credentials.

Enable Search	<input type="text" value="Yes"/>	[STORE VIEW]
	<small>▲ If set to No, search will be done by Magento but indexing will be done by Algolia</small>	
Application ID	<input type="text"/>	[STORE VIEW]
	<small>▲ Your Application ID, which can be found in the Credentials section of your Algolia account.</small>	
Search-only (public) API key	<input type="text"/>	[STORE VIEW]
	<small>▲ A search-only API key (will be included in the public JavaScript code)</small>	
Admin API key	<input type="text"/>	[STORE VIEW]
	<small>▲ Your administration API key (kept private)</small>	
Index Name Prefix	<input type="text" value="magento_"/>	[STORE VIEW]
	<small>▲ If configured, all indices created by the Algolia search extension will be prefixed by this value.</small>	
Enable Auto-completion Menu	<input type="text" value="Yes"/>	[STORE VIEW]
	<small>▲ If set to Yes, the search box will display a search-as-you-type drop-down menu. It requires your theme to expose a <code>top.search</code> template.</small>	
Enable Instant Search Results Page	<input type="text" value="Yes"/>	[STORE VIEW]
	<small>▲ If set to Yes, the products inside the results pages will be searchable the refined results updated as-you-type. It requires your theme to expose a <code>top.search</code> template.</small>	

# Initial indexing

Force the re-indexing of all sections you want to synchronize with Algolia. In your Magento administration navigate to **System > Index Management**. There hit **Reindex Data** button next to these indices:

- Algolia Search Products
- Algolia Search Categories
- Algolia Search Pages
- Algolia Search Suggestions
