



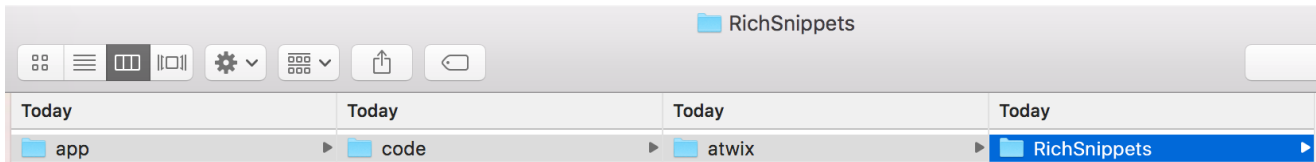

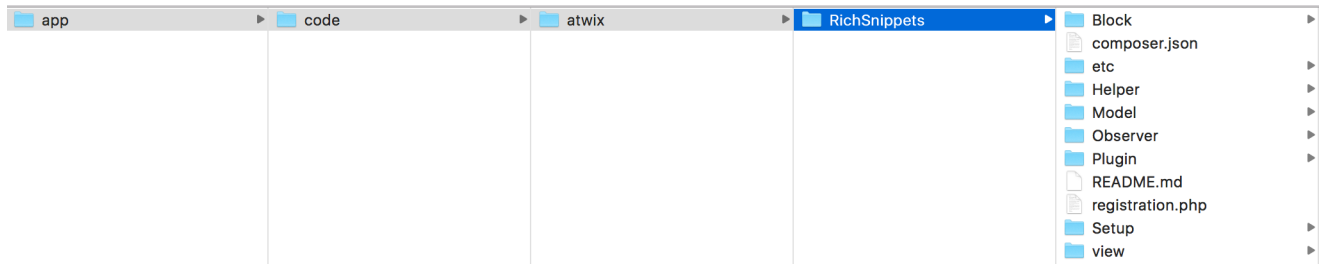

1. Create the following folder: `app/code/Atwix/Richsnippets/`



2. Upload contents of the Rich Snippets installation package to the `app/code/Atwix/Richsnippets/` folder.



3. Flush cache storage


