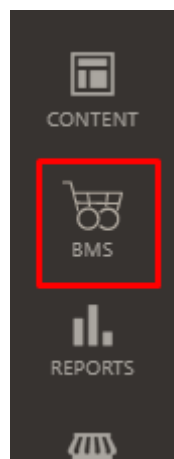
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## Installation

- Unzip files
- Create directory app/code/BoostMyShop/Agent
- Copy all files in this directory
- Run magento command lines :
  - php bin/magento setup:upgrade
  - php bin/magento setup:di:compile
  - php bin/magento setup:static-content:deploy -f

## BMS Menu

Once the module is installed, a new menu entry Boostmyshop is available :



Clicking on this menu show the main Boostmyshop page, from here you can :

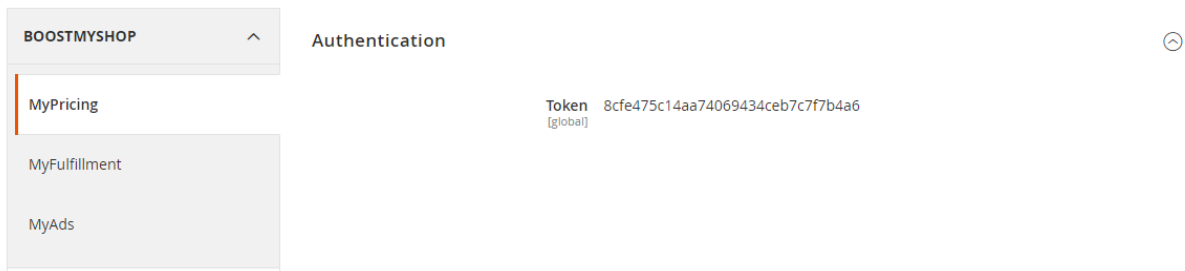

This section allows to configure MyAds conversion tracking.

Available settings :

- Disable: click here if you don't want to add Google conversion trackings on your website
- Include GTAG script : disable this option if you already own a module adding the Google JS libraries
- Google Ads ID : this is your google Ads ID
- Conversion tracking : this is your google Ads conversion tracking ID
- Conversion tracking label : same as above, but for the label
