



# Voice Search User Guide

Magento 2 Voice Search is a module that enables customers to search the store using voice command.

Admin can enable or disable the module from the admin panel.

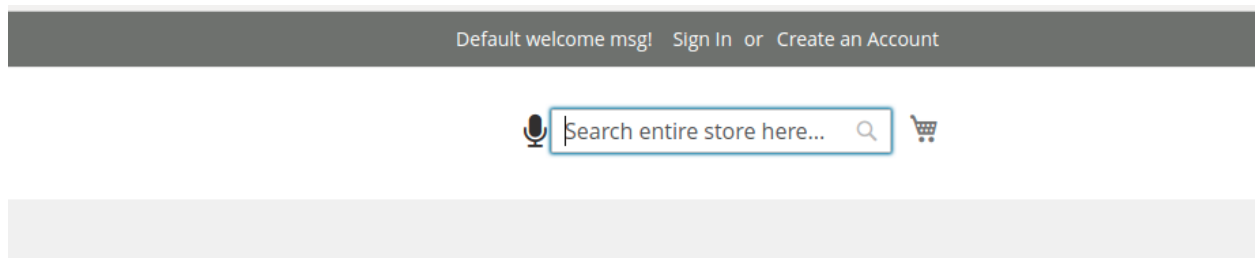
Stores -> Configuration -> Catalog -> Catalog Search

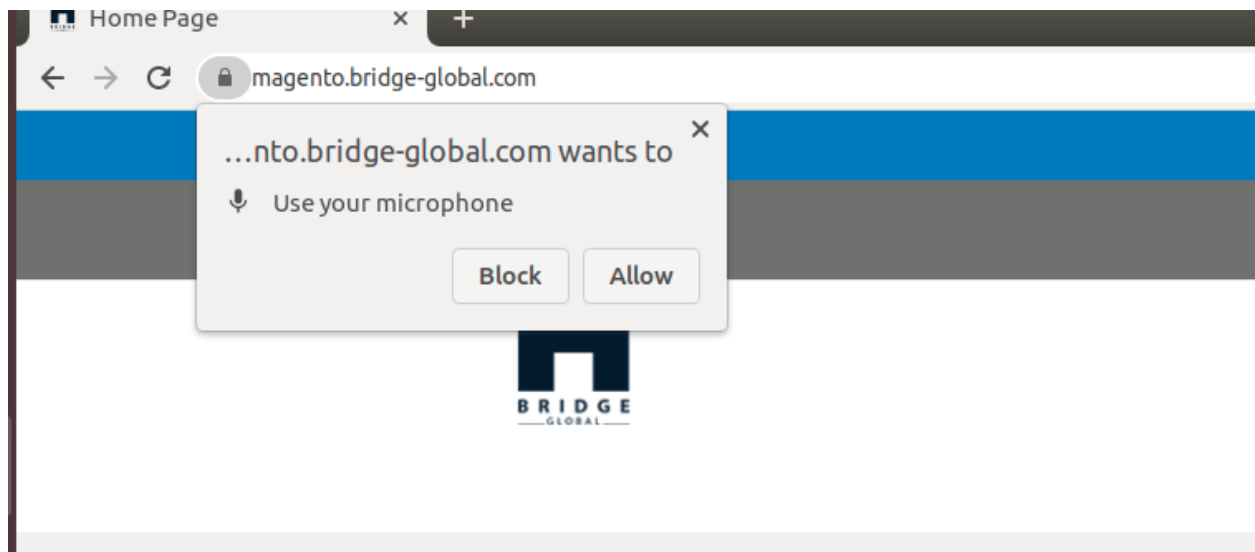

There will be an option to enable or disable the module.

After enabling the module, a mic button will be displayed near the search box.



After clicking the button it will ask for permission to use the microphone in the browser. Click allow to give microphone permission.



Then the mic button will turn red if it is active and ready to accept commands.
