

Clyde's Magento Module Installation

Install the Clyde module for Magento v2 via [Composer](#). If you don't already have composer installed on your machine, instructions can be found here -

Installation instructions from the command line

From the root directory of your Magento installation:

```
$ composer config repositories.clyde composer https://php.fury.io/xumulus/  
composer require clyde/module-warranty
```

```
$ bin/magento setup:upgrade  
$ bin/magento setup:di:compile
```

If your store is in production mode deploy the static content:

```
$ bin/magento setup:static-content:deploy
```

If you are using an external CDN or proxy cache such as Cloudflare or Fastly, you may also need to purge or refresh those as appropriate to your configuration.

Connecting Clyde's Magento extension to Clyde's dashboard

Your API "test" and "live" keys are accessible in Clyde's dashboard in [Settings](#). These keys are used within Clyde's magento extension. Please note that any sales reported with live keys will be billed for - you should keep the extension configured with test keys until you're ready to go live.

You can enter your API keys in the new Clyde menu located under "System". Once they have been added you can trigger a catalog sync immediately from the command line with the following command:

```
$ bin/magento Clyde:sync -p
```

Once you connect with API keys, control of your program, from margin to CTA placement settings, is done within [Clyde's dashboard](#).
