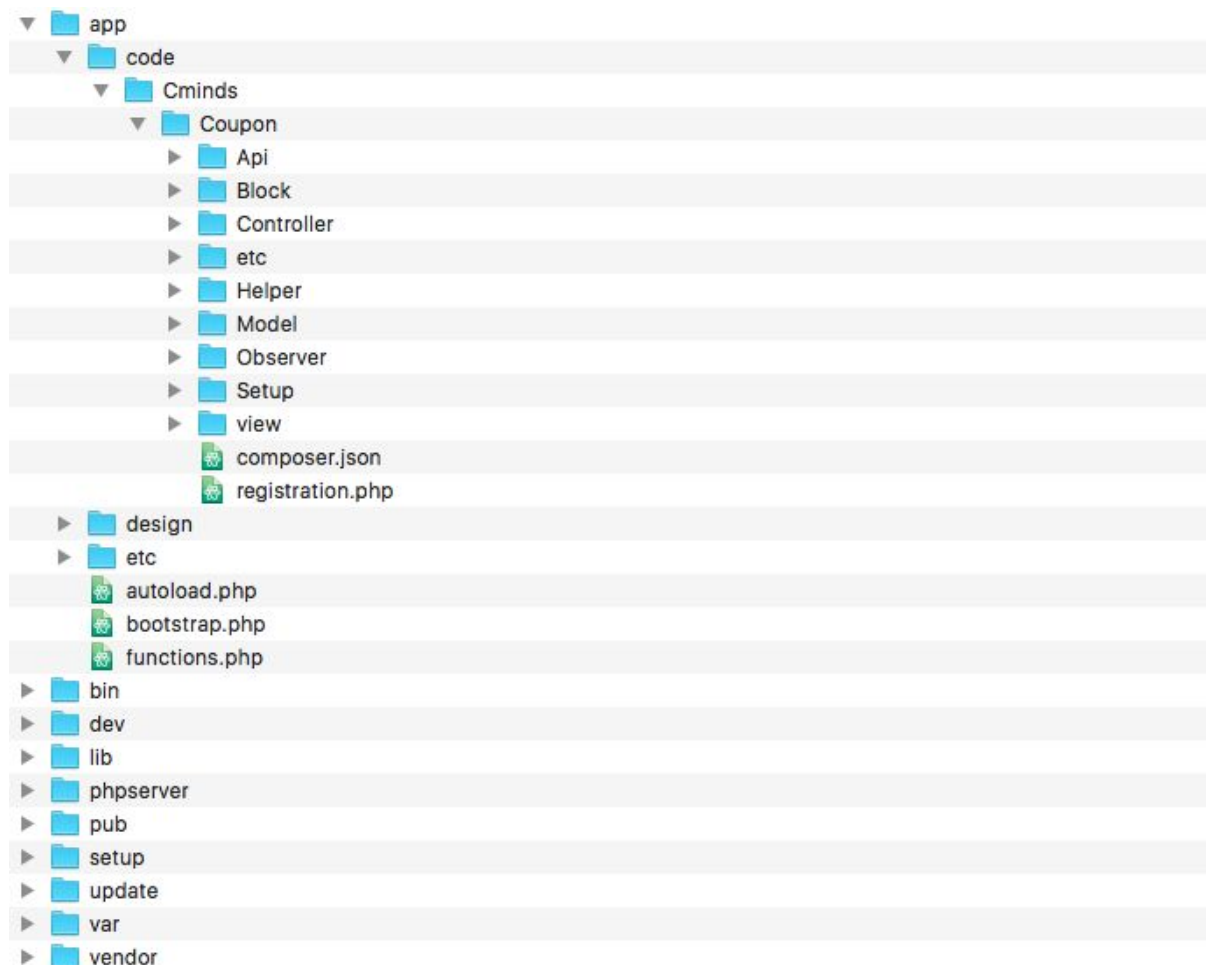


# Magento 2 Extension Installation Guide

If you want to install extension first thing you have to do is create in Magento 2 root category under 'app' the folder 'code'. This folder is a place where you can move extension files - please take a look on the screenshot below. In Magento 2, extension files are placed in one module folder so there is no need to copy files to different directories like it was in Magento 1.



Next step you have to do is install the extension. In Magento root directory using the console please type: "php bin/magento setup:upgrade" and hit Enter. After this do the same with command "php bin/magento setup:static-content:deploy".

```
php bin/magento setup:upgrade
```

```
php bin/magento setup:static-content:deploy
```

After those steps, you should see that our module is enabled. You can check it under app/etc/config.php on the list of enabled modules.

The last thing that you need to do is flush Magento cache. You can do this in two ways, first is by running in console command:

```
php bin/magento cache:clean
```

Second one is in the admin panel, please go to System->Cache Management and select all elements, then click Flush Magento Cache.
