



# Didomi Consent Management: User Guide - Setup

Didomi is a solution that helps companies to collect consents and user data. Didomi generates a valuable trust between companies and their visitors with the Consent Management Platform. You can set up the Consent Management Platform (CMP) directly with the Magento 2 Marketplace.

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Please follow the steps and instructions below to achieve the installation of the CMP on your website.

## Getting the Didomi integration

1. Go on <https://magento.com/>.
2. Click on **Go to Marketplace**.
3. Go on the **Extensions** tab.
4. Go to the **Content & Customisation** section.
5. Then on **Personalization & Experience Management**.
6. Select **Didomi Consent Management**.

## Setup of Didomi Extension

1. In your composer.json file, make sure to have the following url:  
“<https://repo.magento.com>”
2. Update the composer.json file with the **name** and the **version** of Didomi (see “*Find the name and version of Didomi*”).
3. Check that the Didomi extension is properly installed (see “*Enable Didomi Consent Management Extension*”).
4. Enable the extension (see “*Enable Didomi Consent Management Extension*”).

## Find the name and version of Didomi Consent Management Extension

1. Log in to **Magento Marketplace**.
2. Click on **Your Name**.
3. Select **My profile**.
4. Select **My Purchases**.
5. Find the **Didomi Consent Management Extension**.
6. Click on **Technical Details**.

## Enable Didomi Consent Management Extension

1. You first need to clear the Magento-generated static view files. Use the following `module:bin/magento module:enable Didomi_ConsentManagement --clear-static-content`
2. Register the extension using the command: `$ bin/magento setup:upgrade`
3. You should have received a message in Production Mode, telling you to recompile your project. You just need to add this command: `$ bin/magento setup:di:compile`
4. Finally, check if the extension is properly enabled using this command: `$ bin/magento/module: status Didomi_ConsentManagement`
5. Clean the cache: `$ bin/magento cache:clean`

## How to configure Didomi Consent Management Extension

1. Follow this path: **Stores > Configuration > Didomi > Didomi Consent Management**

### Didomi Consent Management

Choose between **yes** or **no** to enable the module.

### Consent Notice JavaScript embed code

Javascript embed code of your consent notice is displayed. Find this code inside the Didomi Console under the **Embed** menu inside the consent notice edition.  
This configuration is compatible with **Domain Targeting** and **Manual Targeting**.

### Display Consent Link In Footer

Choose between **yes** or **no** to display the link in the footer.

### Consent Choice Link Label (if **yes** is chosen in the previous section)

Label of the consent link located in the footer.

### Condition Google Universal Analytics Products Vendor

Choose **yes** to enable or **no** to disable. If you choose **yes**, GUA triggers when the customer gives his consent to "Google Analytics Products vendor (IAB/SDK ID: "c:googleana-4TXnJigR").
