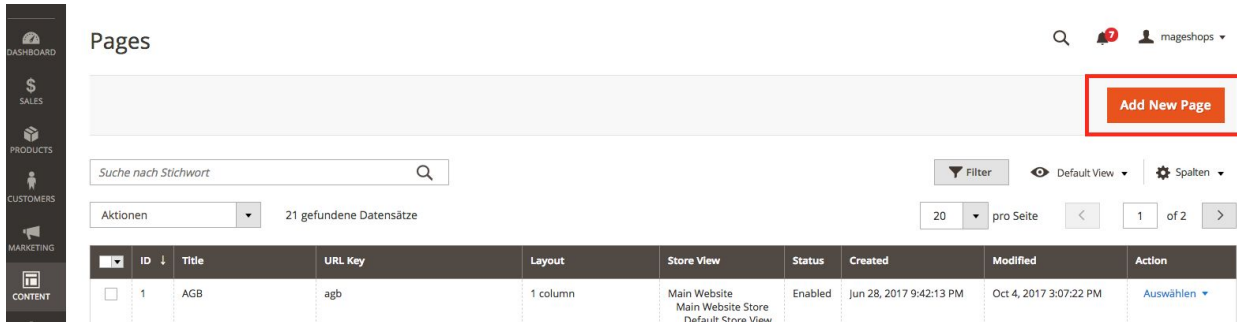




Create a new CMS page

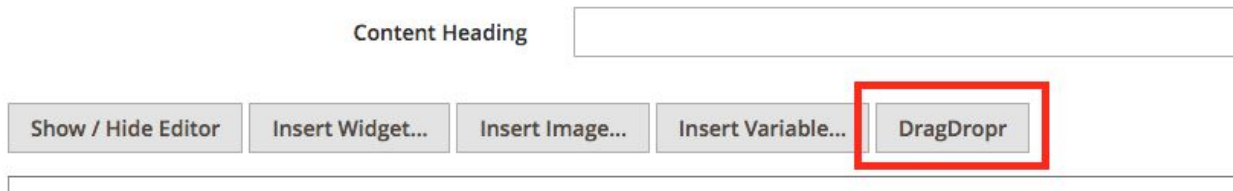
within Magento 2

1. On the Admin Panel, go to **Content > Elements > Pages** and click on **Add New Page**.

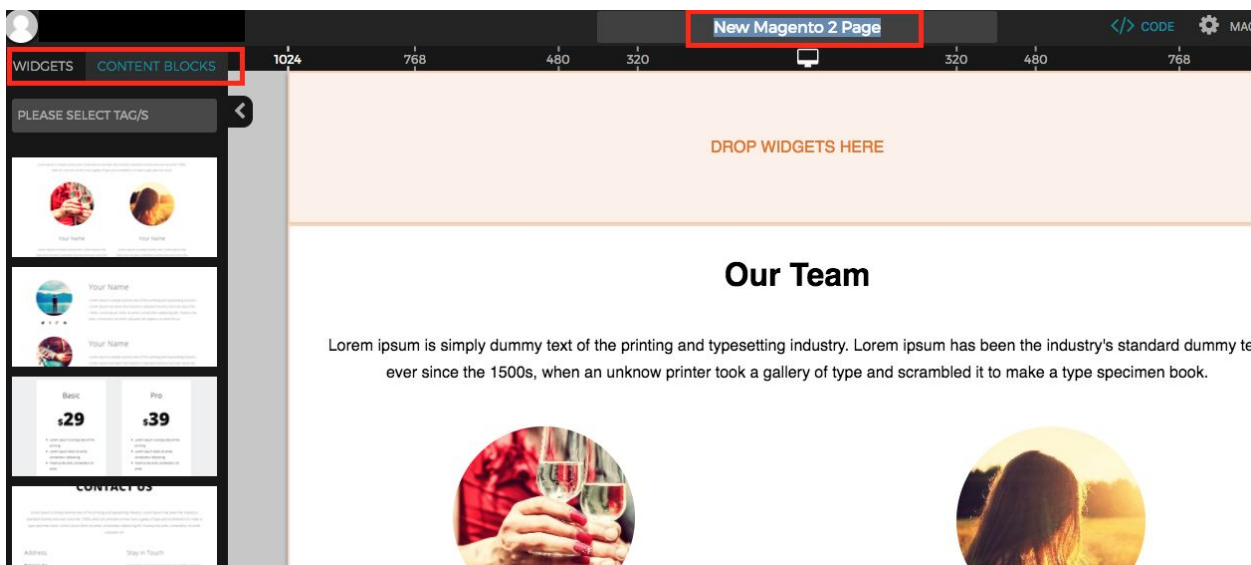


2. Scroll down to the **Content** tab and select **DragDrop** there.

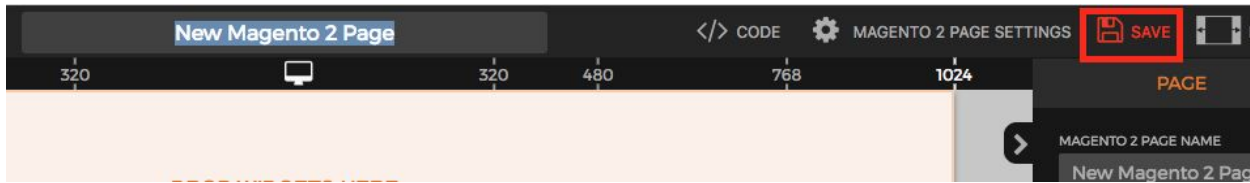

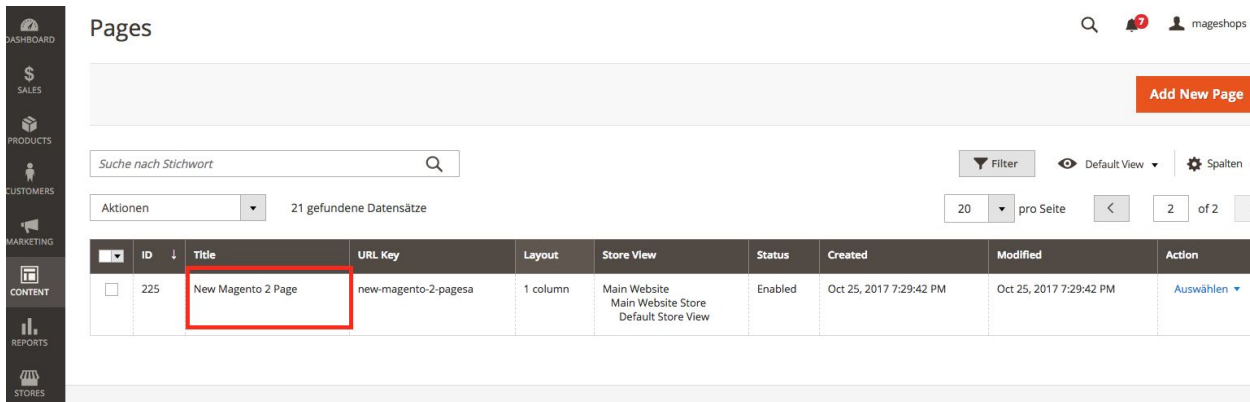
3. You're now redirected to the **DragDrop** page editor. Here, you can add **Widgets** or **Content Blocks** to your page so as to change its name.



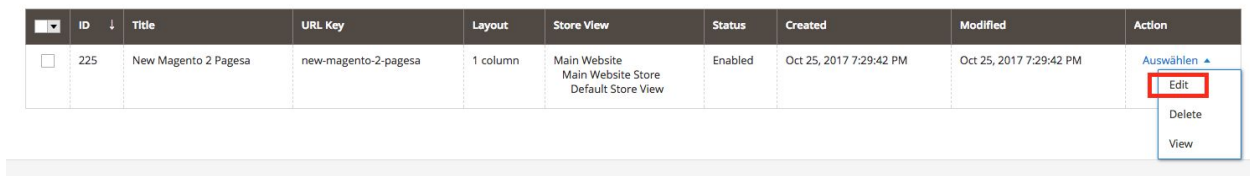
4. Click on **Save** button to save your created page.




5. Go back to **Magento 2** account and go to **Content > Elements > Pages** and find your newly created page there.



6. Click on **Select -> Edit** in order to change your page. You'll see the HTML code in the content field. Click on **DragDrop** button to go to the page editor.



7. Click on **Select -> View** in order to see your page right from Magento account.
