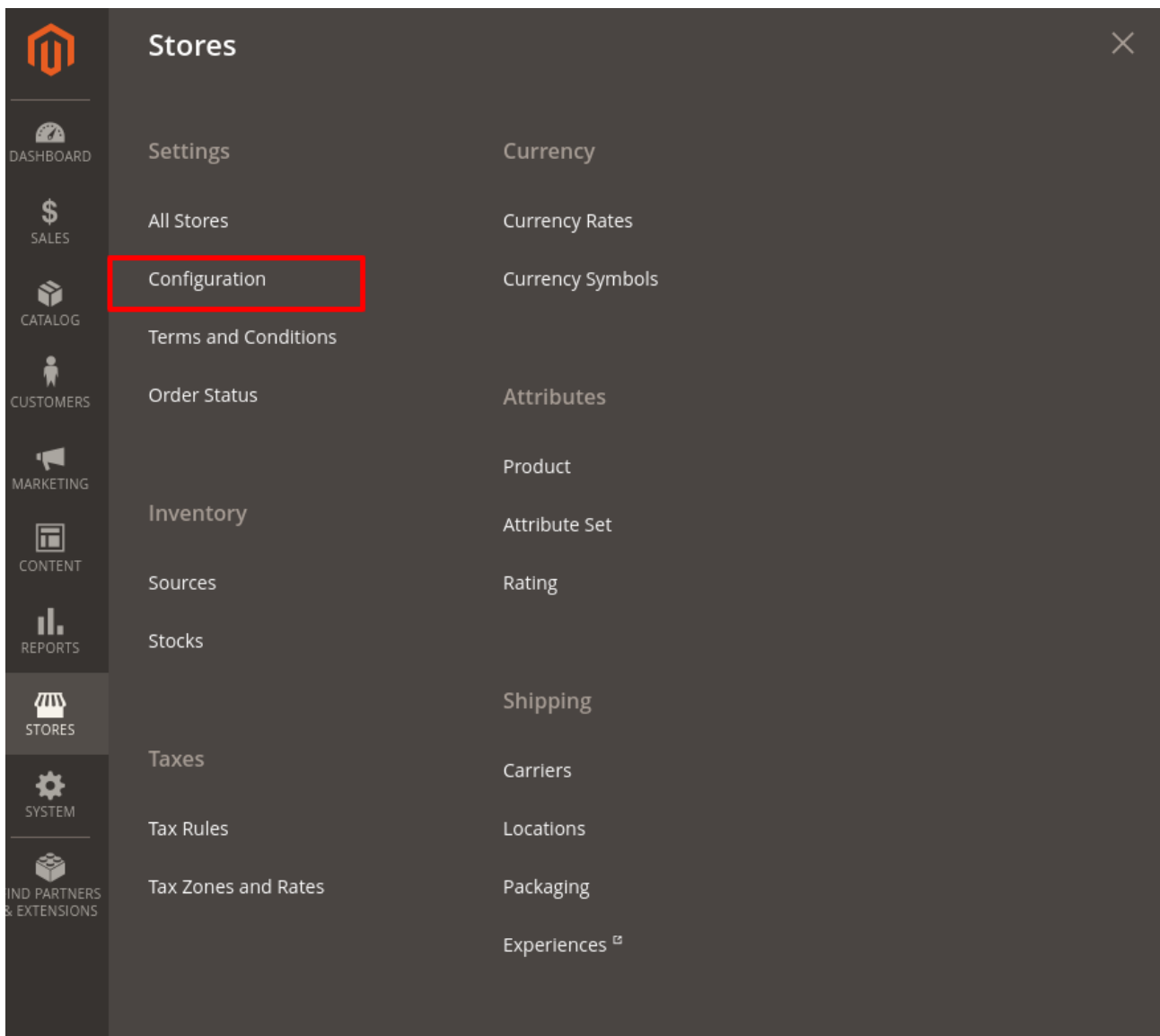


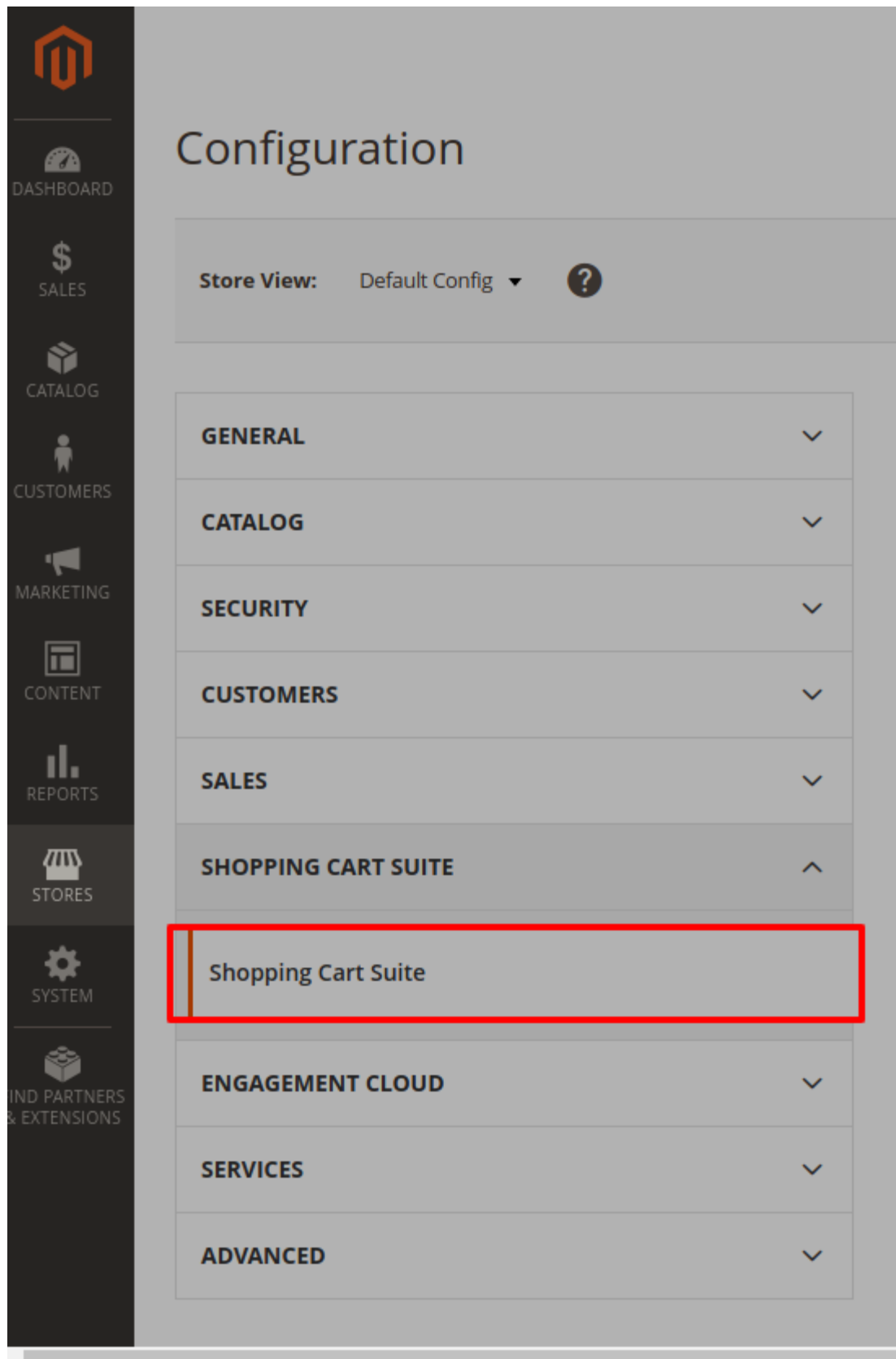
# Shopping Cart Suite User Guide

## 1) How to access to the configuration of the extension

For access to the extension configuration page, go to the magento admin site, in the left menu click on Stores and then in the Configuration option




In the configuration page of the store, scroll down until the Shopping Cart Suite item menu and select it



## 2) Basic configuration

The first section of the configuration is for setting the basic configuration

1. Enable/disable the extension
2. Enter your license key (if you don't have one, please contact our support staff at [shoppingcartsuite@ebizmarts-desk.zendesk.com](mailto:shoppingcartsuite@ebizmarts-desk.zendesk.com) to get one)
3. You can enable/disable the log of the extension here, keep in mind that the log is in `var/log/ShoppingCartSuite.log` file. We recommend disable the log for production sites.
4. With this option enabled, the customer will be redirected to the Shopping Cart page after the sign in.

### 3) Shopping Cart Configuration

This section allows to configure the alerts in the Shopping Cart.

1. Enable/disable this feature
2. Enable/disable the alert when the price of one product in the cart changes
3. Enter the message that you wish to display in the Shopping Cart when a product in the cart increase the price. On this you can use the tags {currentprice} to show the current price of the product and {oldprice} to show the price that the product has in the cart prior to the change
4. Same of 3, but when the price of the product decrease.
5. Enable/disable the alert for low stock situation.
6. All products with stock lower than this will be alerted in the Shopping Cart as with low stock, unless the product have an specific value for this. (you can set this value in the product edit page)
7. Enter the message that you wish to display in the Shopping Cart when the product has low stock
8. The email sender for the alerts emails.

#### **4) Setting up specific alert stock for product**

The stock alert in the Shopping Cart page is controlled by the generic value at the point 6 of the Shopping Cart Configuration, but you can overwrite this logic setting an specific value for a product, for this go to the desired product and edit it, then change the Ebizmarts ShoppingCartSuite min stock field at the end of the main section of the product
