Installation Steps


First of all, you need FTP/SSH access and then follow these steps to complete the installation.



Unpack the Downloaded (ZIP) Package File

Step 1 Upload Eecom folder to the app/code folder of Magento® 2 Installation.

Step 2 Run Upgrade Setup by running this command:
bin/magento setup:upgrade

Step 4



For Re-indexing run this command:
bin/magento indexer:reindex

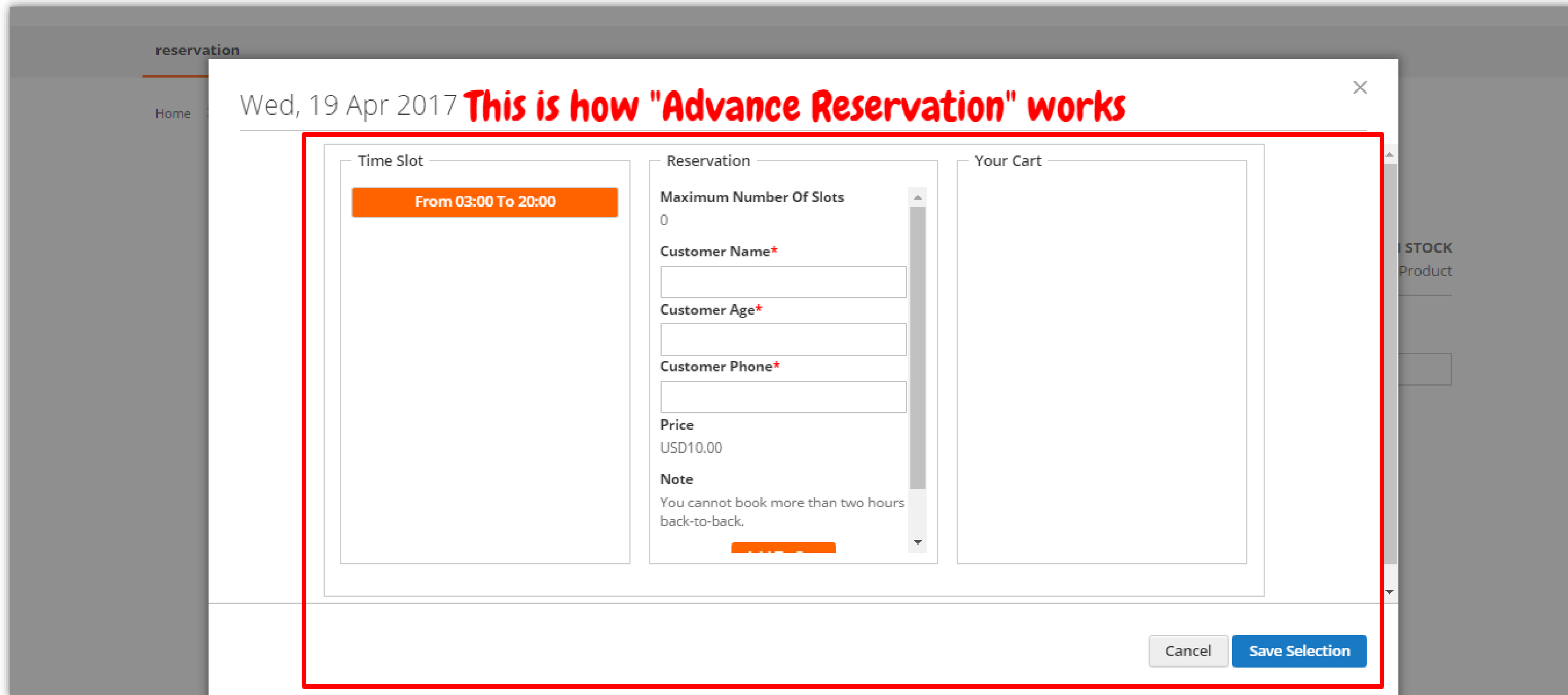
