



# **BANNER SLIDER**

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## **USER GUIDE**

*Version 1.0.0*

Welcome to Banner Slider Extension for Magento 2 developed by eTatvaSoft.

We have provided this guide for better understanding of banner slider extension. We have tried to explain the basic functionality required by every Magento store for the banner slider.

This extension provides a user-friendly approach for banner functionality which is manageable from Magento's admin panel.

## KEY FEATURES:

The extension will provide a separate grid to view and manage banner data and images.

**Title and Images:** Admin can add banner title and image from the backend, and that will be directly displayed on home page of storefront under menu items.

**Buttons, Descriptions, and Links:** Admin can add/specify banner button text, description and redirection link if they want to display button on the banner and redirect the user to specific URL for better sales.

**Position:** Admin can also specify banner position for different banners and it will be displayed on the selected page in ascending order.

**Status:** Admin can set banner status as enabled or disabled according to requirements.

## Follow given below steps to add banners from admin dashboard:

### 1. HOW TO ADD NEW BANNER

From Magento 2 Admin > Banners > Manage Banners > Add New Banner

- **Title:** Title of the Banner. It's an optional field.
- **Image:** Image of the Banner. Please upload image 1920 x 650(height x width) size with jpg, jpeg, gif, png format.
- **Button Text:** Button text which will be displayed on the banner image (Ex. Shop Now), it's an optional field.
- **Button Link:** Add link of the category, product or other pages on which user will be redirected. It's an optional field.
- **Position:** Add Position value to display banners in a predefined sequence. This field will display a banner in ascending order. It's an optional field.

- **Status:** Select Banner status, by default this is enabled. If you want to disable banner you can select this field as disabled.
- **Description:** Add a banner description. This field allows displaying banner description on the storefront with banner image. It's an optional field.

After adding information, click `Save Banner` button to save the banner.

You can also sort/filter them with different attributes like Status, Title, Id, Created Date, Modified Date, Position etc...

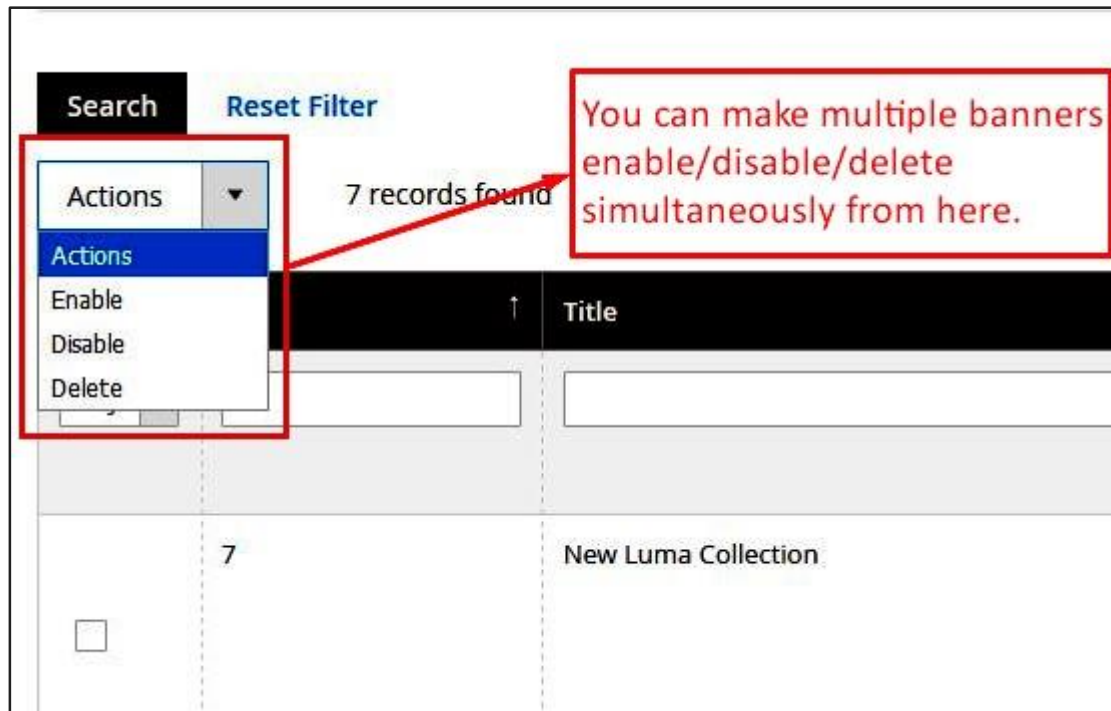

banner with specific title etc...

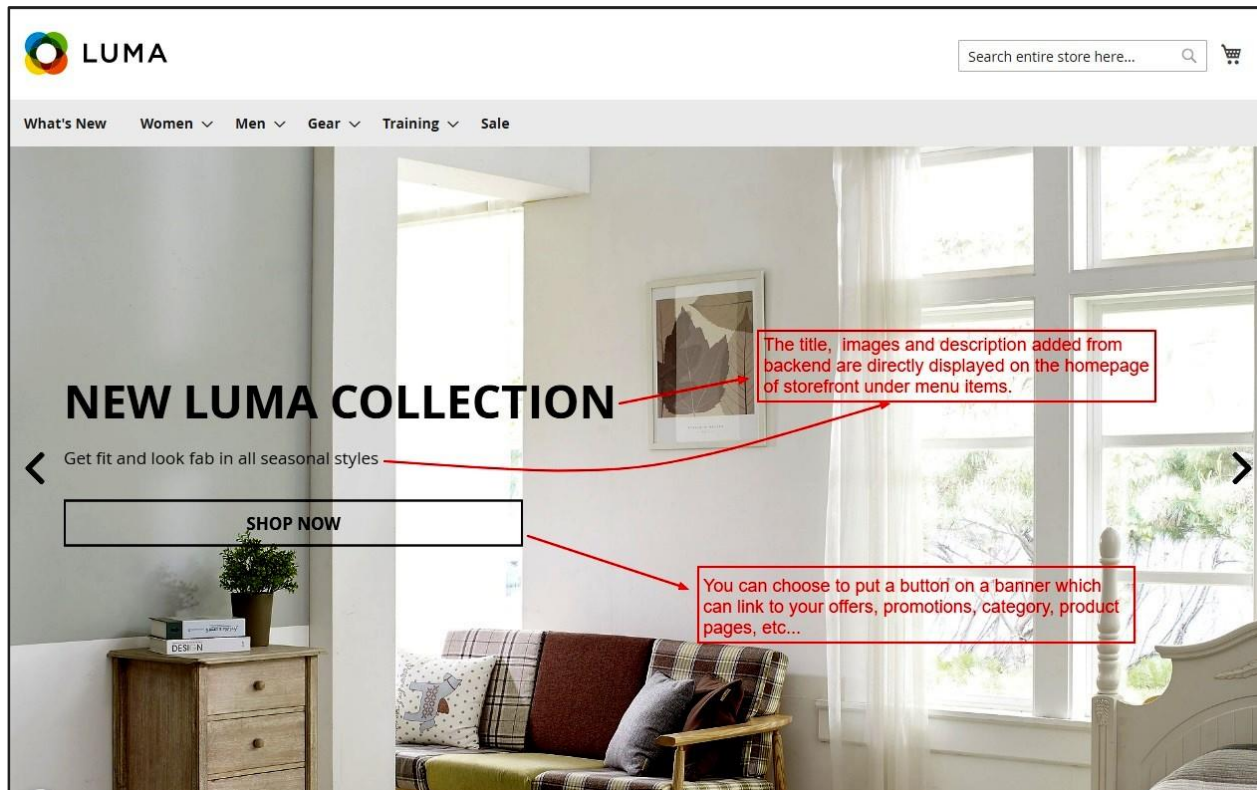
