This is a short user guide for the ETWS Russian Language Pack extension for Magento 2 by ET Web Solutions.

Translation Description

Russian Language Pack for Magento 2 is the interface translation for Magento 2.

The current translation is based on the Russian Language Pack for Magento 1.x. Russian Language Pack is being supplemented with new phrases, that means that phrases, which are removed from Magento by developers, still exist in our translation, so that it would be relevant for any Magento version starting with 2.0.0.

Technical Information for the Developer

Code Encryption / Obfuscation

Extensions developed by ETWS are not encrypted (no IonCube, Zend Guard, etc.).

100% of the source code is open source and not a single line of the code is obfuscated / encrypted.

Observers / Events

The extension does not listens to any events

Class Rewrites

The extension does not rewrite any classes.

Template Overrides

This extension does not rewrite any templates.

Database changes

The extension does not make changes to the database.

How to Install this Extension?

You can install the extension using the following methods:

Composer Installation

1. Run the following command from your Magento site's root directory:
`composer require etws/magento-language-ru_ru:*`
2. Don't forget to clear the cache:
`bin/magento cache:clean`

Manual Installation

1. Download the extension from the [repository](#) and unpack it to a temporary folder
2. Create the path in your Magento site's root directory:
`/app/i18n/etws/ru_ru`
3. Copy the files from the temporary directory to
`/app/i18n/etws/ru_ru`
4. Don't forget to clear the cache:
`bin/magento cache:clean`

If some phrases aren't translated (mostly it's JS), it usually helps to remove static phrases. To remove them simply run:

```
rm -rf var/view_preprocessed/ pub/static/
```
