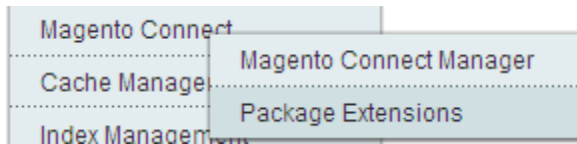
I. Introduction

Install extension from admin:-


Step – 1 Go to admin panel and select ‘Magento Connect Manager’ option from System menu.



Step – 2 Login into ‘Magento Connect Manager’.

Step – 3 Now go to Direct package file upload and Browse your Extension Zip folder and upload your extension.

- Step – 7 After you are following Configuration steps.

Second-

- 1) Download the zip package of module from “**My Downloadable Products**” in store.
- 2) Extract the zip package into a folder in your computer. You should see following folders in the module: *app, js and skin*.
- 3) Disable Magento Cache: Login backend and go to **System > Cache Management**. Select all cache and click Disable button.
- 4) Using FTP client (Filezilla, Winscp...) to upload 3 folders to root folder of your Magento site.
- 5) After you are following Configuration steps.
