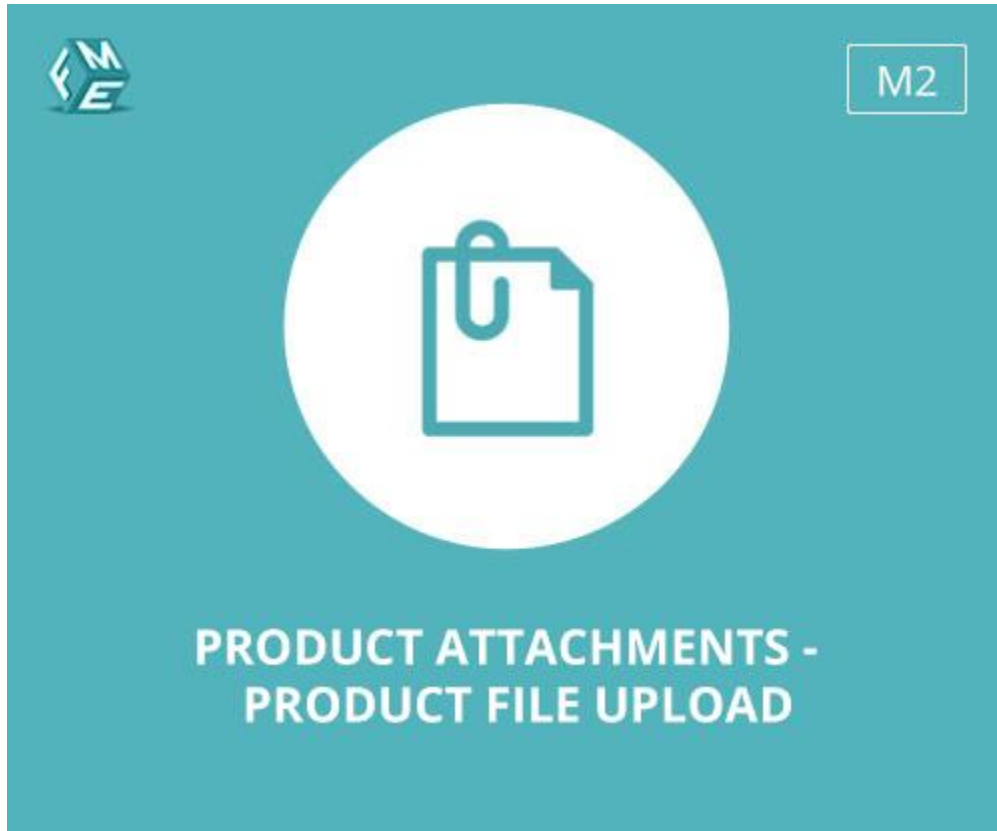

EXTENSION FOR MAGENTO 2

USER GUIDE



INTENDED AUDIENCE

The content of this document is designed to facilitate the users - managers, supervisors, and others of **Product Attachments - Product File Upload** Extension for Magento 2. A step by step instruction has been added to this document to help users to install the extension on Magento 2.

This extension will only work on Magento 2. As a safe practice always backup your files and database before installing any extension on Magento. If you are looking for someone to install the extension we can do it for you as well. Just go to the following link and let support know the order id to expedite the installation process.

Once you have installed please see the User Guide to help you understand how to use the extension to its full capacity. If you still have questions feel free to contact us on our website.



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USER GUIDE

After installation of the extension, make sure the setup is upgraded and static-contents are deployed. Login to the admin panel and flush your Magento cache storage.

HOW TO CONFIGURE THE EXTENSION

At the back end, go to **FME EXTENSIONS > Configurations**. Here you will find the following.

PRODUCT ATTACHMENT SETTINGS

- **Enable Footer Link (Quick Links):** Enable/Disable Footer Links for the extension
- **Show Downloads Counter:** Enable/Disable Downloads Counter. Set download limits to prevent excessive load on your website. You can enable a counter that tracks the number of downloads for each file.
- **Front Name:** Enter the name in front (**Hint:** Make sure to use unique Front Name)
- **Login Before Download:** Enable/Disable login before downloading function
(**Note:** User must be login before downloading any file)
- **List page layout:** Select list page layout as
 - 1 Column
 - 2 Columns with Left Bar
 - 2 Columns with Right Bar
 - 3 Columns
- **Attachments Sort Order:** Specify the sort order of attachments (**Note:** Sort type is ascending)
- **Front Description:** Set Front Description for the extension

PRODUCT DETAIL PAGE SETTINGS

- **Enable Product Attachments:** Enable/Disable the extension
- **Open PDF in New Tab:** Allow PDF files to open in a new tab or same tab
- **Product Attachments Heading:** Set page heading for Product Attachments page
- **Product Attachments Tab Title:** Set page title for Product Attachments page
- **Show Content with Attachments:** Select 'Yes' or 'No' to Show/Hide the content with attachments
- **Show Attachments Under AddToCart:** Select 'Yes' or 'No' to Show/Hide the attachments under add to cart
- **Show Attachments in Footer:** Select 'Yes' or 'No' to Show/Hide the attachments in the footer

- **Show Content with Attachments:** Enable/Disable content showing with attachments

At the backend go to **FME EXTENSIONS > Manage Attachments**. Here you will find all the attachments for the extension added by the admin or the users from the front end. You can **Edit/Delete/Download** any attachment or click on **Add New File** to proceed.

- **Title:** Provide to name of the category
- **Image:** Upload image for the category (**Note:** Upload Image files only: jpg, jpeg, gif, png)
- **Parent Category:** Option to set the category as a root category
- **Store View:** Select store views where the category will be displayed
- **Visible on Front end:** Make category visible at the front end
- **Visible on Product Page:** Make category visible at the product page
- **Status:** Enable/Disable the category

At the backend go to **FME EXTENSIONS > Import Attachments**. Here you will have the option to import all the attachments by clicking on **Import** as shown below.

Make sure that all checks are green.

- ✔ **ProductAttachments_Categories.csv** [Sample](#)
- ✔ **ProductAttachments.csv** [Sample](#)
- ✔ **ProductAttachments_Relations.csv** [Sample](#)
- ✔ **max_input_vars** value is set to **9000**

Above mentioned files must exist under `media/productattachments` with read permissions applied to the directory and files.
Copy all the attachment files to `/pub/media/productattachments/files/downloads/`

Update Attachments
