

Accessibility Enabler Installation for Magento 2

Installation

There are two alternative ways to install this integration, pick the one you prefer and complete its steps.

Option 1 : Without Composer

1. Create A11YEnabler folder in your main Magento directory (/app/code/).
2. Download Magento – A11YEnabler package.
3. Unzip the package to /app/code/A11YEnabler/ folder.
4. Change its name from magento2_a11yenabler to A11YEnabler.
5. Log in to your Magento admin panel and go to System > Cache Management and Flush Magento Cache there.

Option 2: Using Composer

Make sure you have Composer installed. You can install it by entering `curl -sS`


`https://getcomposer.org/installer`. Next, go to the Magento main directory on your server and enter the following commands:

1. `composer require hikeorders/Accessibility-Enabler-Magento2-Extension:dev-master`
2. `php bin/magento module:enable HikeOrders_A11yenabler`
3. `php bin/magento setup:upgrade`
4. `php bin/magento setup:di:compile`
5. `php bin/magento setup:static-content:deploy`
6. `php bin/magento cache:clean`

Connecting the accounts

Now's the time to connect your Accessibility Enabler account to your Magento store.

1. Choose Stores tab from the black menu on the left, and then enter the Configuration section.
2. Select Accessibility Enabler and connect your account by providing your OrgID. Click On Save Config button on to right corner to save the OrgID
