

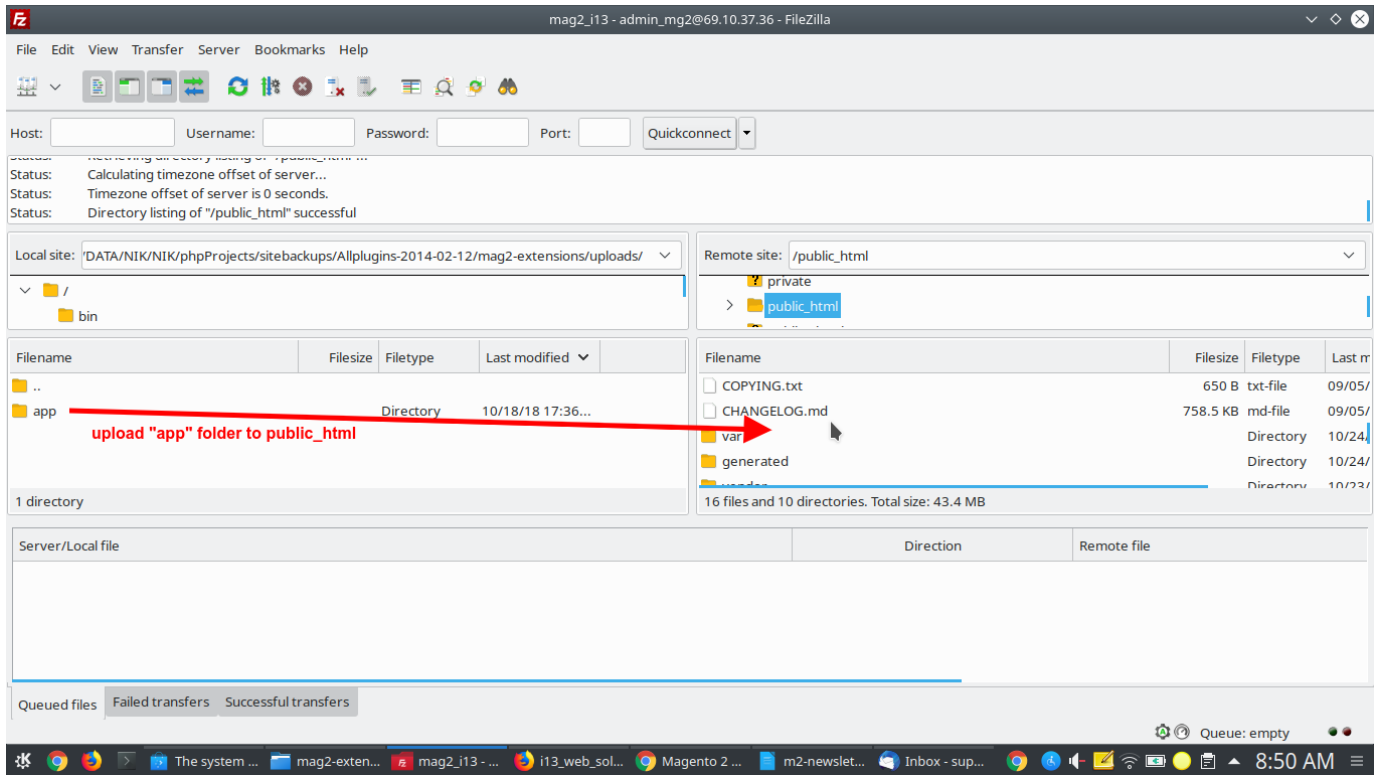


# How to install Newsletter Popup Extension in Magento 2 ?

1. If you wish you can take backup of your store and database
2. Connect to your server ftp and goto **Your Site Root**
3. Extract and upload “app” directory to public\_html
4. No enter to this newly created directory. So finally your path will be look like **Your root directory/app/code/I13websolution/ Newsletterpopup**



5. Login to your host SSH using putty or equivalent software. Goto root of your website using cd command.


**cd your website root directory**

6. Now clear magento 2 cache by following command


**php bin/magento cache:clean**

7. Now install extension by following command


**php bin/magento setup:upgrade**

8. Now Deploy static content by following command

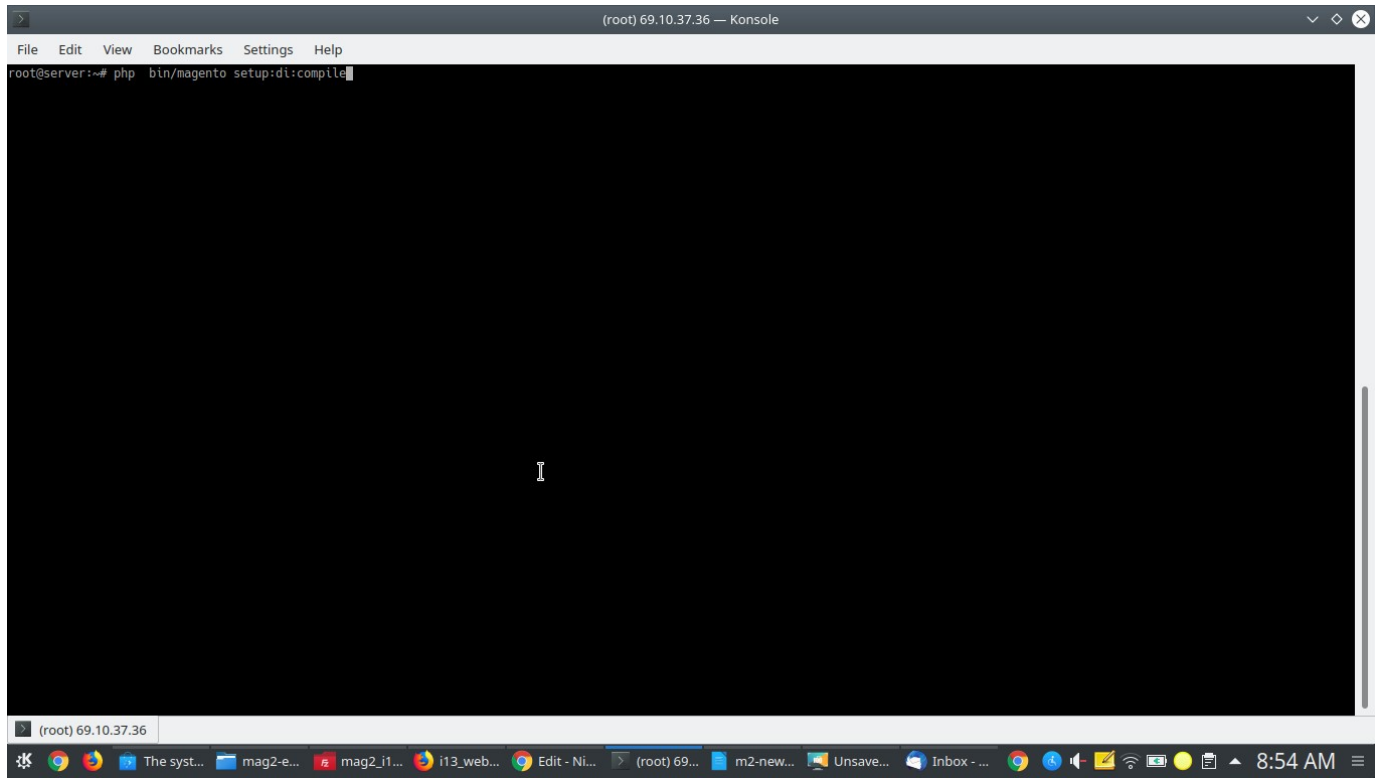
**php bin/magento setup:static-content:deploy**

9. Now Regenerate code using compile command

**php bin/magento setup:di:compile**
