Installation Guide

In order to use the language pack, you must purchase it from the Magento marketplace. The extension is free, but it needs to be associated with your account, so just complete the usual checkout steps.

Once the extension is purchased, install it via composer. In your Magento installation directory, execute the following commands:

```
composer require inchoo/language-hr_hr
```

After installation, execute the following commands to clear the cache and required static files:

```
php bin/magento setup:upgrade
```

If you are doing this in the production environment, please remember that static content and dependency injection definitions need to be recompiled. While doing so, your storefront will be unavailable to the customers. You can do that by executing the following:

```
php bin/magento setup:di:compile
```

```
php bin/magento setup:static-content:deploy
```

Configuration Guide

After installation, the store needs to be configured in order to show Croatian translations. This extension covers both, the admin interface and the storefront.

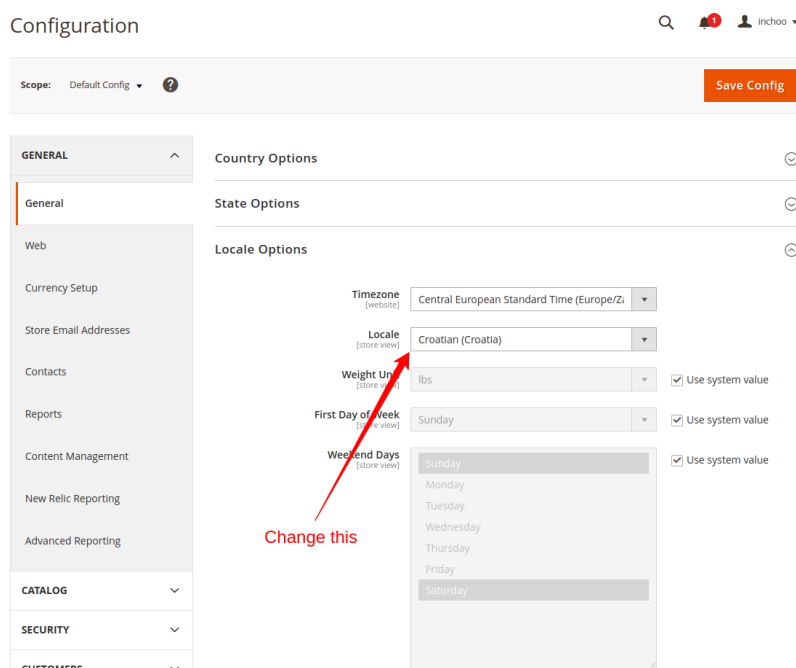
Storefront configuration

In order to use the translations on the storefront, change the configuration located here:

Stores > Configuration > General > Locale > Options > Locale

In that dropdown, you should select “Croatian (Croatia)”. Please note that this configuration can be scoped per website/store, you may want to set it just for just one scope, instead of globally, depending on your store needs.

NOTE: If for any reason this field is grayed out, please refer to the paragraph below the image.



Once you have changed the config value, click “Save Config” and then flush the Magento cache. With the above done, the selected storefront will be automatically translated. You can see how it looks in the [last section of the user guide](#).

NOTE: If the locale option is grayed out and the input is disabled, this means that your store is in production mode. You can not change the locale from admin. Instead, you will need to manually

recompile static content to include new language, and then adjust the config from CLI. The following steps show you how to do so. If you were able to change the configuration in admin, you are all set and can skip to the next chapter.

To recompile static content use the following command:

```
php bin/magento setup:static-content:deploy hr_HR <any_additional_language>
```

Where "*<any_additional_language>*" represents the additional languages you may be using for storefronts and/or admin interface.

For example, if you wish to translate the store from English to Croatian, you need to run the following:

```
php bin/magento setup:static-content:deploy en_US hr_HR
```

You still need to specify the old locale as the config is not yet changed, and you do not want the site to break. Also, your admin interface may still be using en_US as a locale.

After that execute the following command to actually change the locale of your storefront:

```
php bin/magento config:set --scope=stores --scope-code=<your_store_code>  
general/locale/code hr_HR
```

Where "*<your_store_code>*" represents the code of the store you wish to translate (You can see codes under Stores > All stores). For example, if you wish to translate the store with code "*default*" from English to Croatian, you need to run the following:

```
php bin/magento config:set --scope=stores --scope-code=default  
general/locale/code hr_HR
```

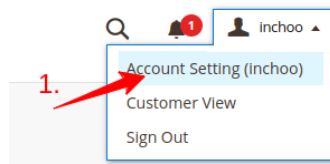
Following the above, clear the cache, either from admin or with the following command:

```
php bin/magento cache:flush
```

Your selected storefront is now displayed in Croatian.

Administration configuration

In order to use the translations in the admin interface, you need to change your account settings.



If you want to change the language in the Admin panel, access your admin Account settings and change Interface Locale to “Hrvatski (Hrvatska) / Croatian (Croatia)”.

Once you changed the setting, type in the password to confirm that is your account and click “Save Account” to apply the changes. Your admin interface is now translated to Croatian as can be seen in the screenshot below:



NOTE: If the *Interface Locale* setting is not displaying other values, it means that you are running the production mode of Magento and do not have those locales compiled yet. You will need to do it manually from CLI. The following steps show you how to do so. If you were able to change the configuration in admin, you are all set and can skip to the next chapter.

To recompile static content use the following command:

```
php bin/magento setup:static-content:deploy hr_HR <any_additional_language>
```

Where “<any_additional_language>” represents the additional languages you may be using for storefronts and/or admin interface.

For example, if you wish to translate the admin from English to Croatian, you need to run the following:

```
php bin/magento setup:static-content:deploy en_US hr_HR
```

You still need to specify the old locale, as it is still used by other admins, possibly storefront, and you still haven't changed your settings, so you need it for a bit longer.

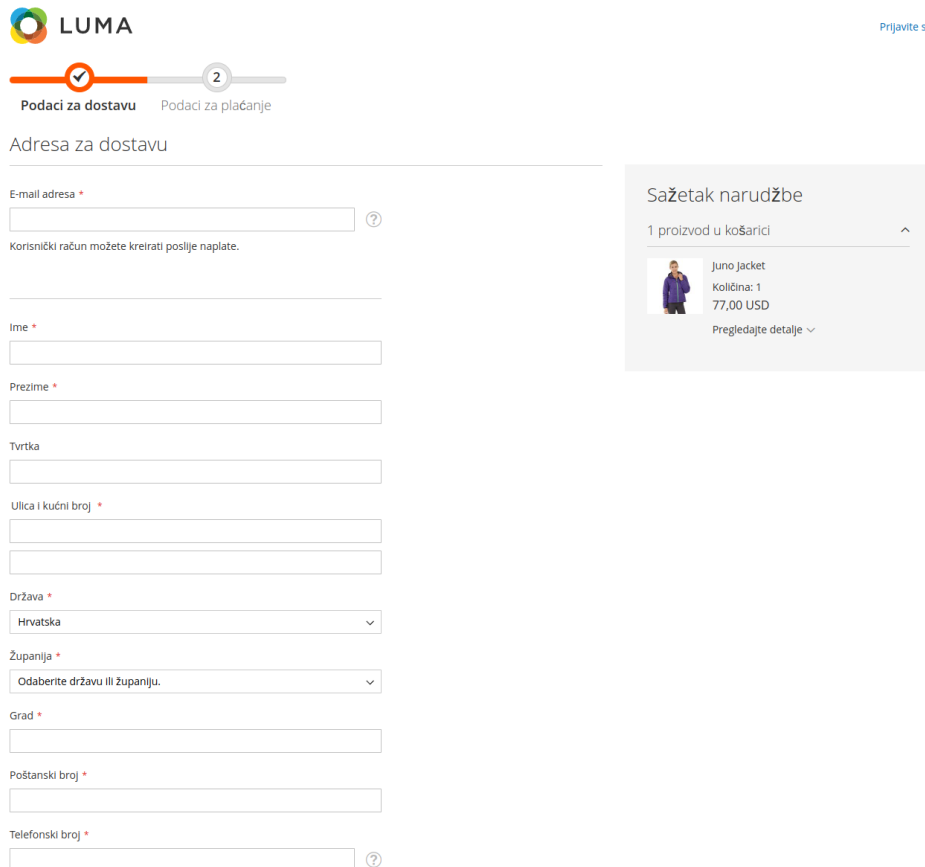
Once you complete these steps, you will be able to select Croatian as an Interface Locale under your account settings.

Storefront usage

There are no special actions that customers need to do, based on the admin configuration, translation will be automatically applied (if enabled by configuration). You can see it in action on the following screenshots:
