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Introduction

Universal extension to popup any html content, image or form on loading of page or on specific customer action. Promote your products, news, ads, and events or collect information From user by any kind of form like newsletter, or any custom Form through attractive popup window.

Installation

- Backup your web directory and store database
- Download extension installation package
- Disable Magento Cache run command "**php bin/magento cache:disable**" using SSH from your magento root directory
- Upload contents of the extension installation package to your "**app/code/MageArray/Popup**" directory
- Then run commands "**php bin/magento setup:upgrade**" using SSH from your magento root directory
- Enable Magento Cache run command "**php bin/magento cache:enable**" using SSH from your magento root directory



You can limit width to max width px if % width is wider than max px.

Show at Home page ▼
Leave unselected (empty) if you want to show popup at all pages.

Exclude Url
Use if you want to exclude page or url pattern. Write page url (e.g. www.magento.com/aboutus?). Use single comma (e.g. www.magento.com/contacts/www.magento.com/about?) to separate multiple urls.

Add/Edit Popup
(Popup Info Tab)

Title - You can specify Popup name.

Popup Content Type - It's two types (Custom Content, Image).

- Custom Content (editor)
 - Description - It will contain Popup description where you can add HTML, Image, etc. using editor.
- Image
 - Image Uploader - Choose files (Allow image type: jpg, jpeg, gif, png).

Popup content width - It will set popup width.

Popup width unit - It will choose width unit (px or percentage) to make responsive popup for mobile devices.

Popup content max width (in px) - It will set popup max-width to make responsive popup for mobile devices

Show at - Popup show particular page.

- All pages (popup show on full site)
- Homepage (popup show on only homepage)
- Checkout (popup show on only Checkout Onepage)
- Cart (popup show on only cart)
- Specified url (popup show on only specified url.)
 - Specified Url (Write page urls on which you want to show, use single comma to separate multiple urls.)

Exclude Url - Use if you want to exclude page or url pattern.

Show when - popup will show particular events.

- After page is loaded
- Define seconds after page is loaded
 - second (Write how many seconds after page loads the popup should appear.)
- Define seconds user spent on entire site
 - second (user spend time on site. After that show popup).
- After user uses scroller
 - Scrolling px (Show popup after scrolling how many px from the top of the page.)
- On click
 - Click selector (Write click selector e.g. #idName, .class Name, div input#idName.)
- On hover
 - Hover selector (Write hover selector e.g. #idName, .class Name, div input#idName.)
- Exit intent (When mouse leaves browser window popup will show)

From Date - (Popup will show from this date). Date is in local store view time.

To Date - (Popup will show till this date). Date is in local store view time.

If 'Show only once', popup with the same id won't be shown again until cookie lifetime expires.

Cookie lifetime in days

You can use also decimal dotted number (e.g.: To expire cookie in 1 hour put 0.04 which means 1 day divided with 24 hours.)

Close when click outside popup

Available for popups with background overlay.

Close automatically after x seconds

Leave 0 or empty if you don't want popup to be closed automatically

Showing Frequency - popup showing frequency.

- Show until user closes it (if user click close button popup will not appear until cookie expires).
- Show only once (popup will show only one time).
- Show every time (user can show popup every time page loads).
- Show once per session (user can show popup per day one time).

Cookie lifetime in days - set cookie lifetime (You can use also decimal dotted number. To expire cookie in 1 hour put 0.04 which means 1 day divided with 24 hours).

Close when click outside popup - Available for popups with background overlay.

Close automatically after x seconds - Leave 0 or empty if you don't want popup to be closed automatically.

If product in cart


- Skip this condition

Cart subtotal less than - popup will show when cart subtotal less than amount, Leave empty or write 0 if you don't want to apply this condition.

Cart subtotal more than - popup will show when cart subtotal more than amount, Leave empty or write 0 if you don't want to apply this condition.

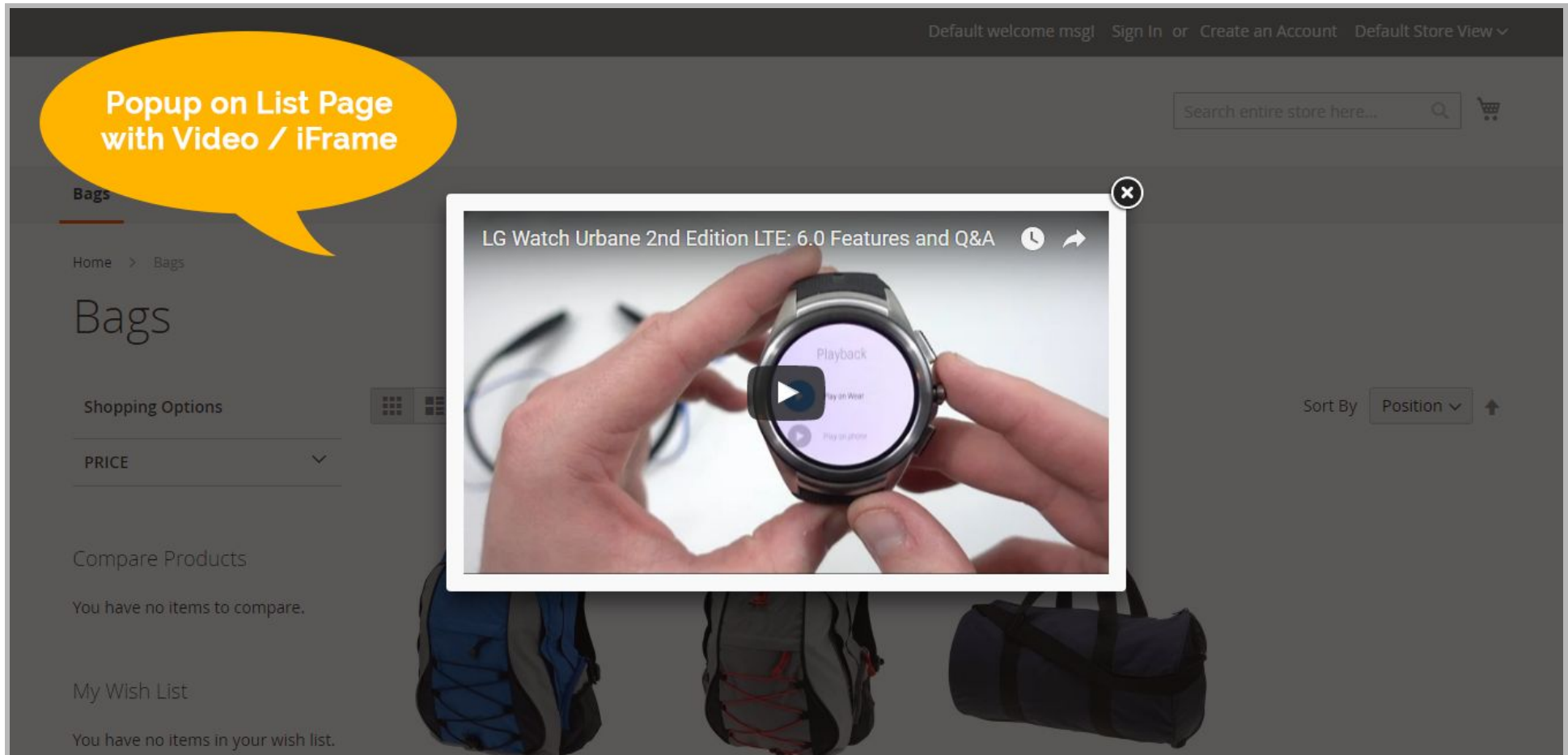
