Full features list

- 1)Simplified display subcategory on category page.
- 2)Create category listing on any page using widget.
- 3)You can Define No of columns you want to use in Grid.
- 4)Placeholder image for catalog to use if category thumbnail not available.
- 5)You can hide particular subcategory from catalog grid/list.
- 6)Grid Or List view layout of subcategory catalog.
- 7)Image Resize based on backend height and width.

### Installation

- Backup your web directory and store database
- Download extension installation package
- Disable Magento Cache run command "**php bin/magento cache:disable**" using SSH from your magento root directory
- Upload the contents of the extension installation package to your "**app/code/MageArray/SubcategoriesGridList**" directory
- Then run commands "**php bin/magento setup:upgrade**" using SSH from your magento root directory
- Enable Magento Cache run command "**php bin/magento cache:enable**" using SSH from your magento root directory

##### Subcategories Grid/List Configurations

To configure the Easy Catalog Images Extension for Magento, navigate to **Stores >> Settings >> Configuration >> MageArray Extensions >> Subcategories Grid/List**

### General Setting

- **Enabled** - You can set Module yes/no.
- **Use Category Image When Thumbnail is Not Available** - You can set yes/no for using category image when thumbnail image not available.
- **Placeholder Image** - You can set placeholder image which become available when category does not have image.
- **Subcategories Layout** - You can set frontend view layout from grid or list view.
- **Image Height** - You can set image height .By default it is 200px.
- **Image Width**- You can set image Width.By default it is 200px.

Note: Image Height, Image Width is used as intrinsic values. Other settings Like Number of columns , Layout have higher priority over these settings, so you may not get the result as per above settings.

In case these setting has higher values than the image uploaded then background will be amended automatically.

- **Change To 1 column Layout** - You can set 1 column layout for subcategories grid/list page.

### Category Level Settings For Subcategories Grid/List

To enable subcategories grid/list for category navigate to **Products >> Category**
