

Restrict Order Extension User Manual



Magento 2 Restrict Order Extension by MageComp allows the store owner to restrict specific customer group orders based on country, city or zip code.



1. Extension Installation Guide

- Go to My downloadable products. The file that you download normally is a zip file.
- Use FTP client (such as Filezilla, WinSCP, cuteFtp) to upload or copy all folders in the zip package to your Magento site root folder. This will not overwrite any existing files, just add new files to the folder structure.
- Open Command line in folder root of Magento and run following command respectively:
 - `php bin/magento setup:upgrade`
 - `php bin/magento setup:static-content:deploy`
 - `php bin/magento indexer:reindex`
 - `php bin/magento cache:flush`
- Navigate to Stores/Configuration, if you can see the extension tab, it is installed properly.
- If you need professional help regarding Magento Extension Installation, feel free to contact us any time.

2. Configuration

Once you have successfully installed the extension, go to **Stores → Configuration** to configure the extension for use.

Upload CSV file along with countries , cities and zipcodes for which you want to accept orders.

- **Restrict Order:** Enable or disable extension from here.
- **Apply Group Filter:** Option to restrict order functionality for specific customer group.
- **Select Customer Groups:** From here, you have to select customer groups for which you want to restrict order placement functionality.

3. Manage Allowed Locations:

Using this grid, you can manage locations such as country, city as well as zip codes from which you want to accept orders. You can use star to include all zip code in case if needed.


City * Enter the city for which you want to enable orders

- **Select Customer Groups:** Enter zip code for which you want to enable orders.


4. Restrict Orders in Frontend

Once you have setup all the configuration, the extension will allow customer to place an order if they fulfilled all the conditions.



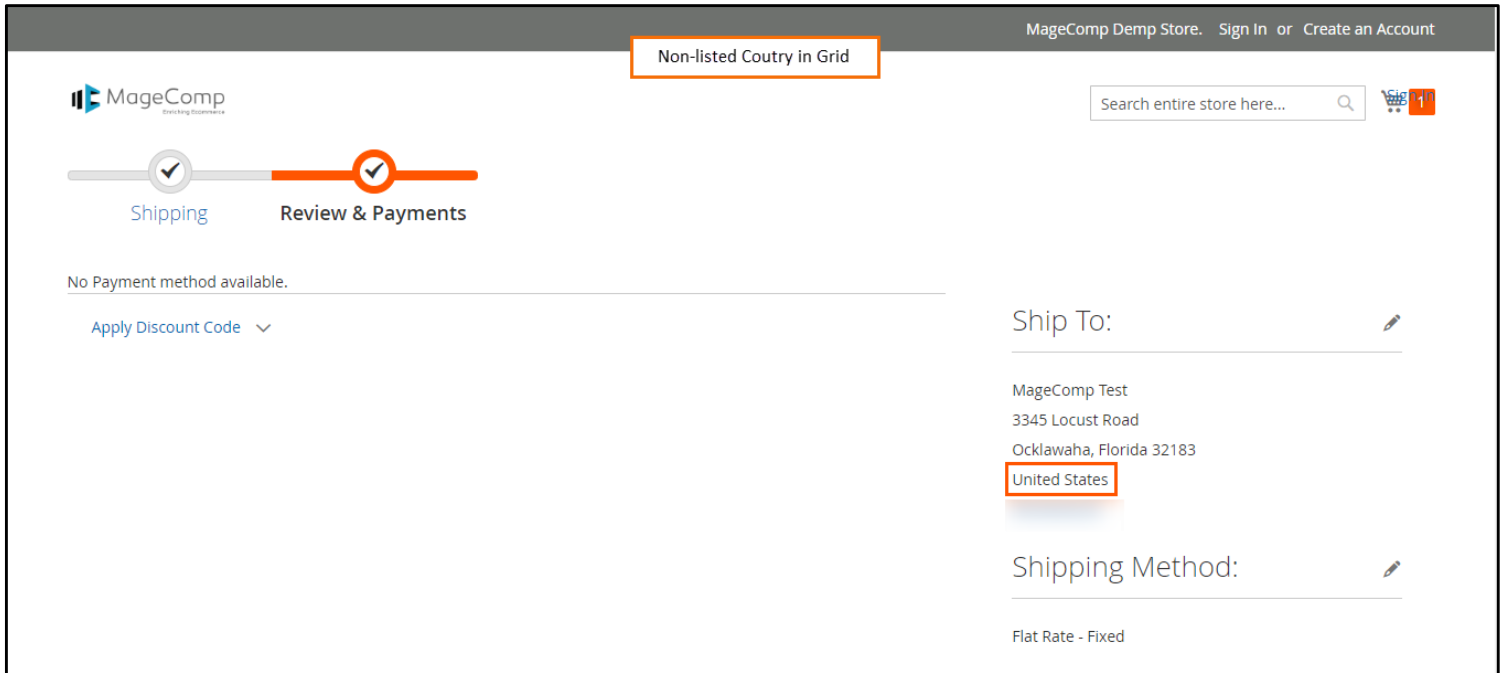

- Go to `app` → `etc` → `config.php` and find '`Magecomp_Restrictorder=> 1`', and replace 1 with 0.
