

Minimum Order Fee Extension User Manual



Magento 2 Minimum Order Fee by MageComp allows you to charge small order fee for the purchase that is below set minimum order amount.

1. Extension Installation Guide

- Go to My downloadable products. The file that you download normally is a zip file.
- Use FTP client (such as Filezilla, WinSCP, cuteFtp) to upload or copy all folders in the zip package to your Magento site root folder. This will not overwrite any existing files, just add new files to the folder structure.
- Open Command line in folder root of Magento and run following command respectively:
 - php bin/magento setup:upgrade
 - php bin/magento setup:static-content:deploy
 - php bin/magento indexer:reindex
 - php bin/magento cache:flush
- Navigate to Stores/Configuration, if you can see the extension tab, it is installed properly.

2. Configuration

Once you have successfully installed the extension, go to **Stores → Configuration** to configure the extension for use. Here you can find various settings for the extension.

- **Order Fee:** Enable or disable extension from here.
- **Refund Order Fee:** Option to refund minimum order on order cancellation.
- **Minimum Order Amount:** Enter minimum order value to charge customers with minimum order fee if order total is below this specified amount.
- **Minimum Order Fee:** Enter minimum order fee to charge your customer if order value is bellowed than specified minimum order amount.
- **Minimum Order Fee Title:** Set title to display small order fee in frontend.
- **Apply Group Filter:** Select YES to enable minimum order fee for specific customer groups.

3. Minimum Order Fee in Frontend

Once you finish settings, when people add products to cart with lesser minimum amount, they get charged with minimum order fee.


