Installation Guide

Follow the instructions below to install your MageMaclean extension.

There are 2 options to install your Magento 2 extension:

- **1) Composer installation** from command line (recommended)
- **2) Copy and paste** the files to your magento installation

Before installing your new magento extension, backup your website directory and database.

After you have purchased our extension from the Magento Marketplace you can install our module with option 1. If you purchase your module from our website or choose to download our module from the Magento Marketplace, you can install using option 2.

Please note, our Core module will be required for installation of any modules purchased from MageMaclean. For more information about our core module, please visit: <https://www.magemaclean.com/m2-core/> .

Our Core module will be automatically installed as a dependency when you install your new extension using the composer method. If you choose to install using the copy and paste method, you will also need to download the Core module from our website.

Option 1) Install Using Composer:

1. Connect to your website with SSH and navigate to your Magento root directory.
2. Run the following commands:

```
composer require magemaclean/m2-additionalemails
```

```
php bin/magento setup:upgrade
```

```
php bin/magento module:enable MageMaclean_AdditionalEmails
```

```
php bin/magento setup:di:compile
```

```
php bin/magento cache:flush
```

Option 2) Copy and Paste:

- Download from Magento Marketplace:

1. Login to Magento Marketplace with the username and password you used to purchase your MageMaclean extension;
2. Download our extension from the section "My Purchases".

- Download from MageMaclean website:

1. Login to your account at www.magemaclean.com
2. Download your magento extension from "My Account" > "My Downloadables" after you have purchased your paid or free extension on our website.

- Install your downloaded extension:

1. Unpack the extension ZIP file on your computer.
2. Connect to your website source folder with FTP/SFTP/SSH client and upload all the files and folders from the extension package to the corresponding root folder of your Magento installation.
3. Connect to your website with SSH and navigate to your Magento root directory.
4. Run the following commands:

```
php bin/magento setup:upgrade
```

```
php bin/magento module:enable MageMaclean_AdditionalEmails
```

```
php bin/magento setup:di:compile
```

```
php bin/magento cache:flush
```
