

Advanced Breadcrumbs for Magento 2.x

User Guide

Extension Settings

Go to “Stores > Configuration > MagestyApps Extensions > Advanced Breadcrumbs” in Magento admin area in order to see the extension’s general settings.

General Settings

Add structured data (rich snippets) [STORE VIEW]

Add structured data (rich snippets) - enable/disable structured data markup for breadcrumb links

Breadcrumbs on Product Pages

Force show full path [STORE VIEW]
If 'Yes' then the full path to product will be shown in breadcrumbs even when visitors open a product page from a middle category.

Enable 'Search results' breadcrumb [STORE VIEW]
Displays "Search results for..." breadcrumb when viewing a product from search results page.

Show only one path [STORE VIEW]
This setting makes sense when a product is assigned to multiple categories.

Default category [STORE VIEW]


Force show full path - always shows a constant breadcrumbs path on product page independently on the last opened category

Enable 'Search results' breadcrumb - this setting allows to show “Search Results for...” in breadcrumbs panel when user comes to a product from search results page.

Show only one path - this setting is needed when a product is assigned to multiple categories. If it is set to “Yes” then only one category path will be shown. If “No” then all the available paths will be displayed.

Default category - if the “Show only one path” setting is set to “Yes” then you can choose the prior category for breadcrumbs. The longest path which includes the selected category will be shown.

Hide duplicated categories - this setting allows to hide duplicated categories when multiple breadcrumbs paths are displayed.



Breadcrumbs on Additional Pages		
Customer Account pages	Yes	[STORE VIEW]
Cart and checkout pages	Yes	[STORE VIEW]
Contact Us page	Yes	[STORE VIEW]

Customer Account pages - adds breadcrumbs block to all the customer account pages.

Cart and checkout pages - adds breadcrumbs to cart and checkout pages.

Contact Us page - show breadcrumbs on “Contact Us” page.
