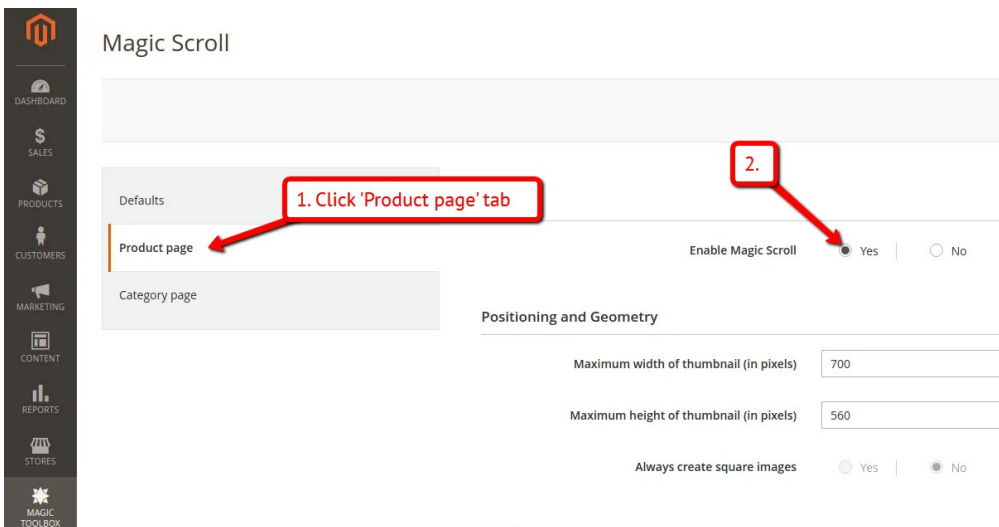

ENABLING MAGIC SCROLL:

Go to the [Magic Toolbox > Magic Scroll] menu in the Magento admin panel.

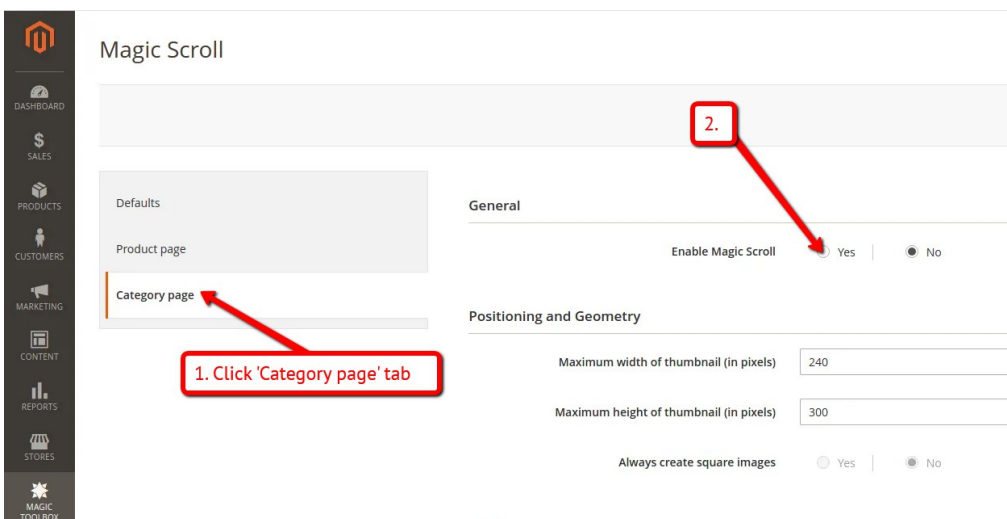
To enable Magic Scroll on the 'Product' pages of your store:

1. Click the 'Product page' tab.
2. 'Enable Magic Scroll' > Select 'Yes'.
3. Save change.



To enable Magic Scroll on the 'Category' pages of your store:

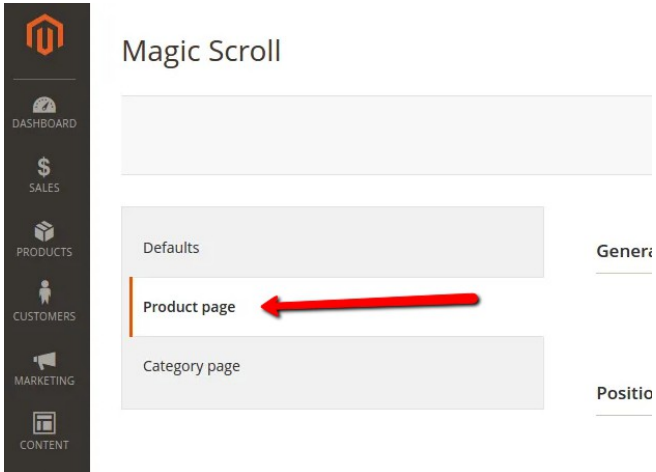
1. Click the 'Category page' tab.
2. 'Enable Magic Scroll' > Select 'Yes'.
3. Save change.



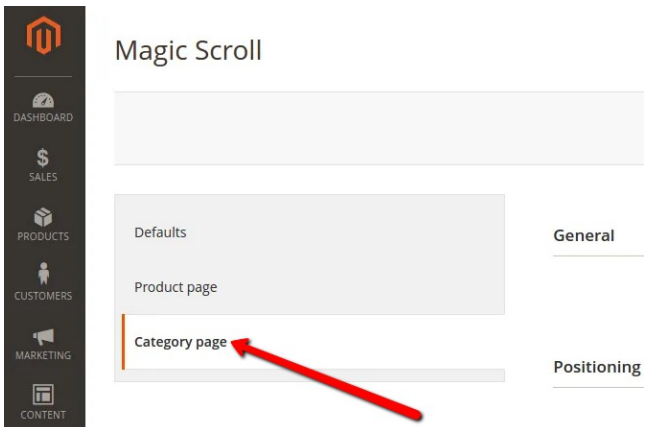
CUSTOMIZING:

Customize Magic Scroll settings to suit your needs - go to the [Magic Toolbox > Magic Scroll] menu in the Magento admin panel.

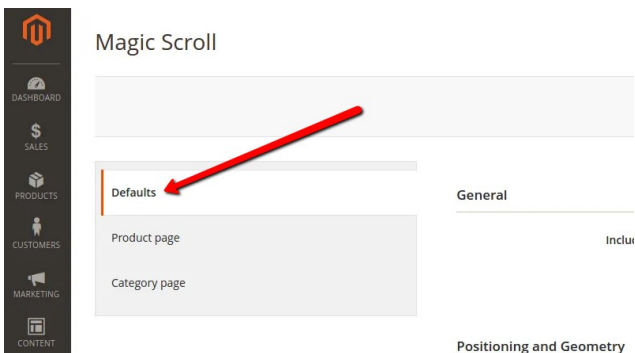
For customizations to only apply to Product pages, make all changes on the 'Product page' tab:



For customizations to only apply to Category pages, make all changes on the 'Category page' tab:



If you would like customizations to apply to both Product and Category pages, make changes on the 'Defaults' tab:



HOME PAGE CAROUSEL:

There is no dedicated home page settings page for Magento 2 but you can still create an amazing slider on the homepage of your store using HTML.

In your **home page content area or template**, create a div with a class of **MagicScroll**. Sliders can have as many images as you want. Here is a scroll of 7 images, each linking to a URL:

```
<div class="MagicScroll">
  <a href="/page-1/"></a>
  <a href="/page-2/"></a>
  <a href="/page-3/"></a>
  <a href="/page-4/"></a>
  <a href="/page-5/"></a>
  <a href="/page-6/"></a>
  <a href="/page-7/"></a>
</div>
```

CMS PAGE CAROUSEL:

Add an image carousel to any CMS page on your Magento store:

1. On the Magic Scroll extension settings page, set the '**Include headers on all pages**' parameter to 'Yes' (under the **Defaults** settings tab).
2. Go to your admin panel > CMS > Pages. Add a new page or select an existing page.
3. On the 'Content' tab click on the 'Show/Hide Editor' button to disable the editor.
4. Insert Magic Scroll anywhere in the code. It requires a div with a class of **MagicScroll** and all your carousel images inside. For example:

```
<div class="MagicScroll">
  <a href="page1.html"></a>
  <a href="page2.html"></a>
  <a href="page3.html"></a>
  <a href="page4.html"></a>
</div>
```

5. Click 'Save Page'.
6. Click 'Preview' to see your scroll in action!
