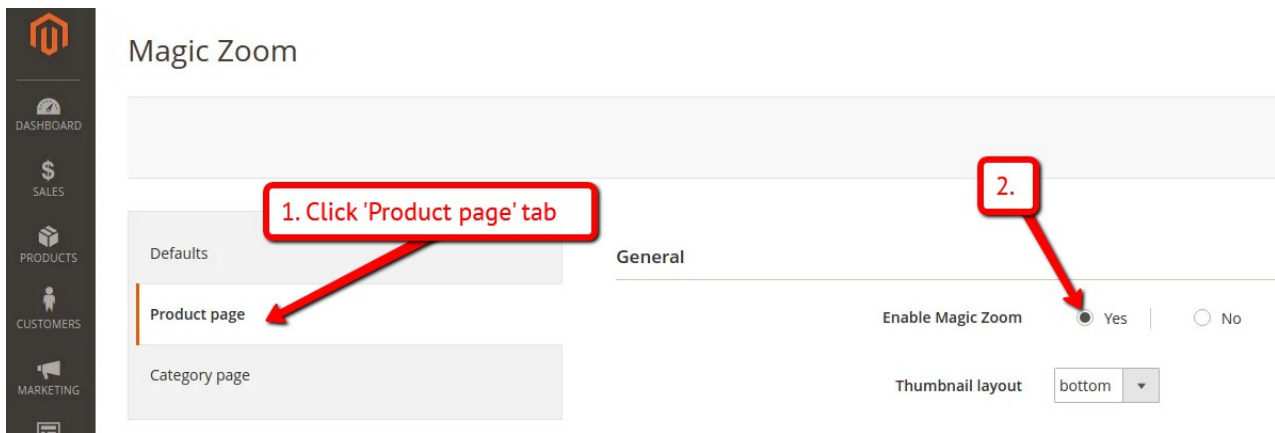

### ENABLING MAGIC ZOOM:

Go to the [Magic Toolbox > Magic Zoom] menu in the Magento admin panel.

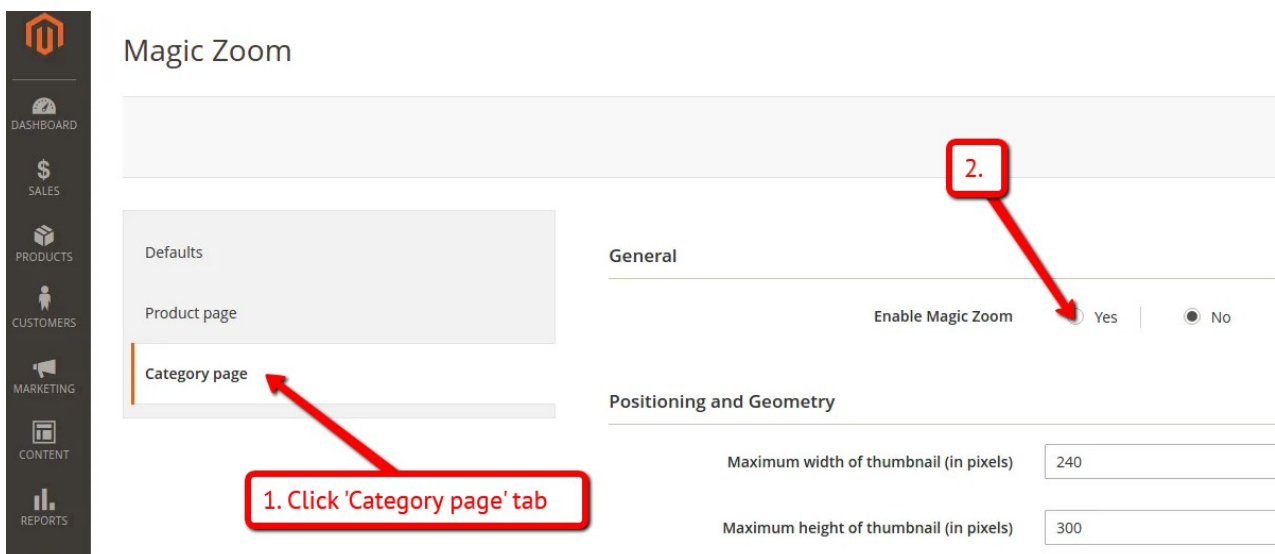
To enable Magic Zoom on the 'Product' pages of your store:

1. Click the 'Product page' tab.
2. 'Enable Magic Zoom' > Select 'Yes'.
3. Save change.



To enable Magic Zoom on the 'Category' pages of your store:

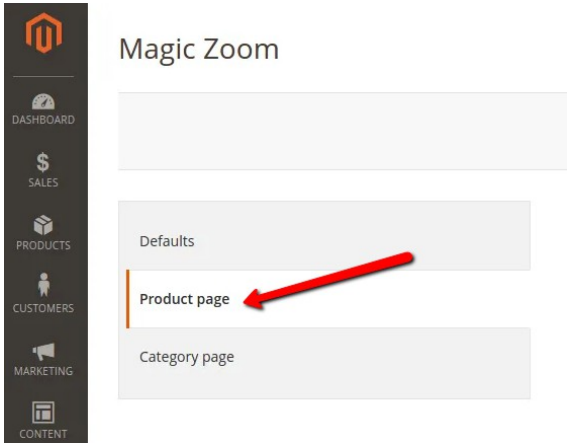
1. Click the 'Category page' tab.
2. 'Enable Magic Zoom' > Select 'Yes'.
3. Save change.



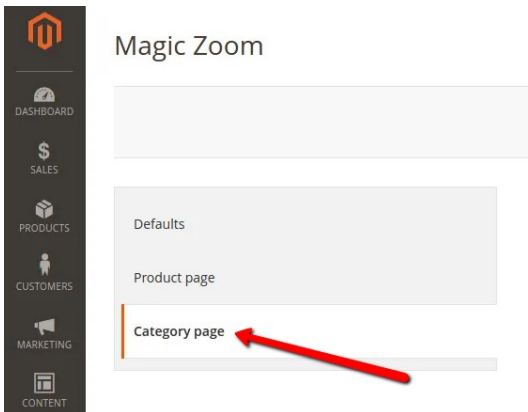
## CUSTOMIZING:

Customize Magic Zoom settings to suit your needs - go to the [Magic Toolbox > Magic Zoom] menu in the Magento admin panel.

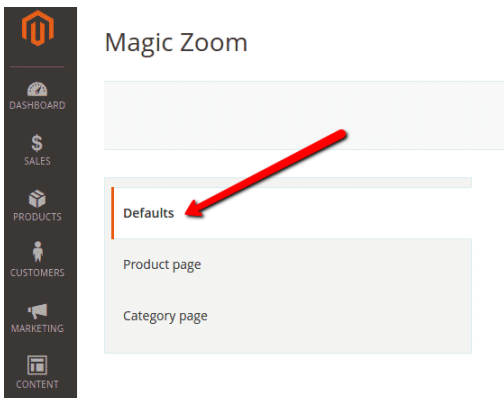
For customizations to only apply to Product pages, make all changes on the 'Product page' tab:



For customizations to only apply to Category pages, make all changes on the 'Category page' tab:



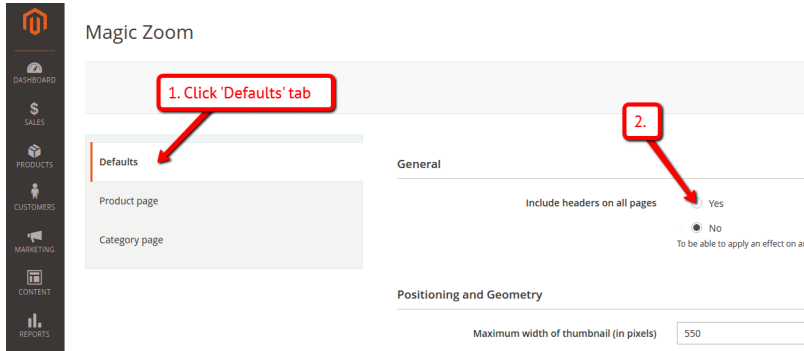
If you would like customizations to apply to both Product and Category pages, make changes on the 'Defaults' tab:



## CMS PAGE ZOOM:

Add an image zoom to any CMS page on your Magento store:

1. On the Magic Zoom extension settings page, set the 'Include headers on all pages' parameter to 'Yes' (under the **Defaults** settings tab).



2. Go to your admin panel > CMS > Pages. Add a new page or select an existing page.

3. Click '**Content**' tab > Click '**HTML**' button (a pop up box will appear).

4. Add zooming to any image on your CMS page by referencing the small and large images. Reference your small image with `<img>` and link it to your big image using the CSS class of "**MagicZoom**". Your code will look something like this:

```
<a href="big.jpg" class="MagicZoom"></a>
```

5. Click '**Update**' > Click '**Save page**'.

## COMBINE ZOOM & VIDEO:

Magic Zoom supports native product videos functionality. Combine zoomable images & video on any of your Magento 2 product pages. To add a video...

1. Go to: Catalog > Products > [Your product].

2. Scroll down to 'Images and Videos' section > Click 'Add Video' button > Browse for video > Click 'Save' button.
