

SwissID Plugin Guide

For Magento 2

SwissID

This application provides the possibility for a customer to log in with his/her SwissID account. Thus, customers can log in securely and easily. In addition, this module enables age verification through SwissID. Thus, you can introduce a general age restriction or one targeted at specific product categories. To use the SwissID authentication module, you must be a registered Relying Party (RP). The registration is carried out by SwissSign AG. To do this, you must contact SwissSign via support@swissid.ch.

Installation using Composer

Magento® 2 use the Composer to manage the module package and the library. Composer is a dependency manager for PHP. Composer declare the libraries your project depends on and it will manage (install/update) them for you.

Check if your server has composer installed by running the following command:

```
composer -v
```

If your server doesn't have composer installed, you can easily install it by using this manual:

Step-by-step to install the Magento® 2 extension through Composer:

1. Connect to your server running Magento® 2 using SSH or other method (make sure you have access to the command line).
2. Locate your Magento® 2 project root.
3. In case that you have purchased the plugin through the marketplace you can go ahead to step 4, otherwise you can add our private repository with your details from your account on magmodules.eu and run the following command:
composer config repositories.magmodules composer https://packages.magmodules.eu/
4. Install the Magento® 2 extension through composer and wait till it's completed:
composer require magmodules/magento2-swissid
5. Once completed run the Magento® module enable command:
bin/magento module:enable Magmodules_SwissID
6. After that run the Magento® upgrade and clean the caches:
php bin/magento setup:upgrade
php bin/magento cache:flush
7. If Magento® is running in production mode you also need to redeploy the static content:
php bin/magento setup:static-content:deploy
8. After the installation:
Go to your Magento® admin portal and open 'Stores' > 'Configuration' > 'SwissID.
