
Installation Manual for Magento 2.x Extensions by Medma Infomatix

This Installation Manual provides you the appropriate guidance for Installing Magento 2.x Extensions much easily and quickly. We offer you great Installation and Support Services all for free!

To install a Magento 2.x extension:

Before you begin, make sure that your system meets the prerequisites for Component Manager.

1. Log in to the Admin of your Magento store as a user with full administrator rights (make sure that **CRON** is configured to run every minute).
2. On the Admin side bar, tap → **System**, then under Tools, choose **Web Setup Wizard**.
3. Select **Component Manager** and click **Sign In** link in the upper-right corner.
4. When asked, paste the **Public Access key** and **Private Access Key** from your Marketplace account. Then click on **Sign In**.




5. To synchronize Component Manager with your marketplace

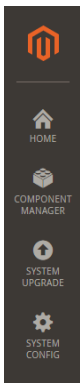

- Your store will be put in maintenance mode while the backup is created. By default, the backup includes the code, media, and database. Clear the checkbox of any item that you do not want to include in the backup.

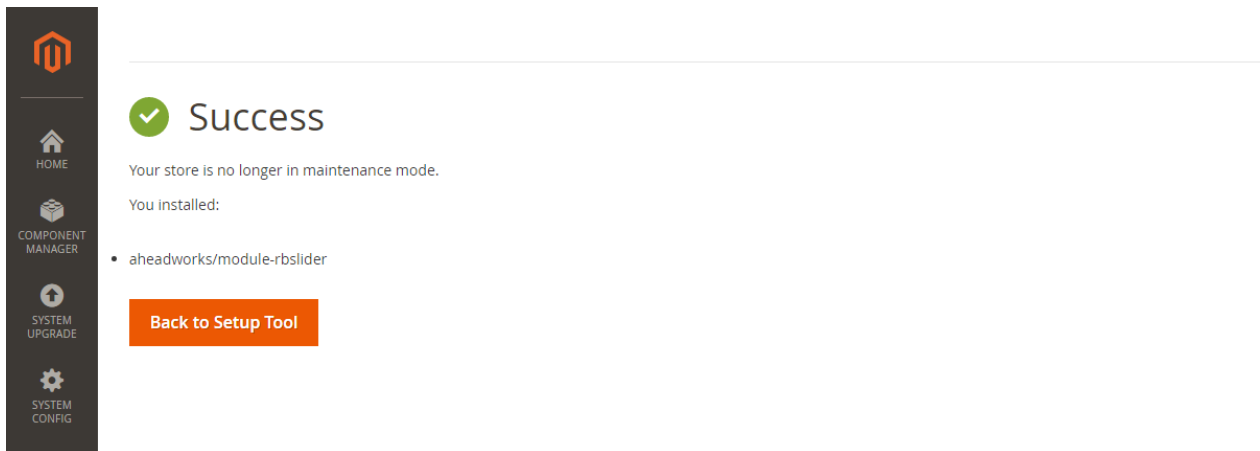

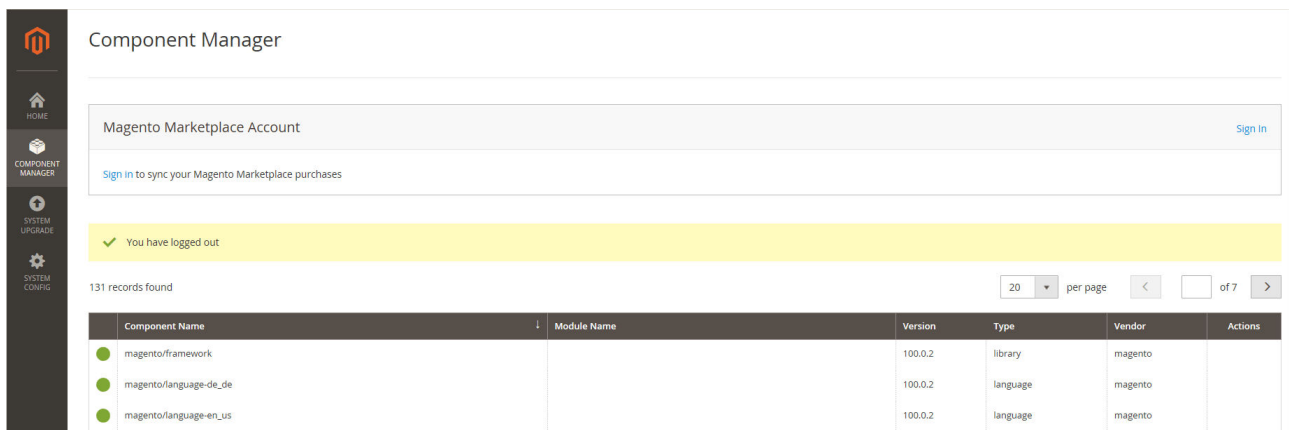

Install

- Depending upon your Cron setting, it might take some time for the installation to complete. The page shows current status, and you can track its progress in the Console Log. The success page appears when the process is complete.



- When complete, click **Backup to Setup Tool**. Then, tap the **Component Manager** tile.
- In the upper-right corner of the Component Manager, click the **Reset** link to log out.



Step 4: Configure the Extension for your store :

- Log in to the Admin of your store.
- In the panel on the left, find the new tab for the extension you installed. Then, follow the instructions from the extension developer to complete the configuration, if applicable.
- Navigate to **Stores -> Configuration -> General setting -> Enable module**. Select 'Yes' to enable the module, 'No' otherwise.
