

# Restrict Fake Registration for Magento 2


## 1. Extension Installation

- Create a folder structure in Magento root as app/code/Meetanshi/Restrictuser
- Download and extract the zip folder and upload our extension files to the app/code/Meetanshi/Restrictuser via FTP.
- Login to your SSH and run below commands step by step:
  - php bin/magento setup:upgrade
  - For Magento version 2.0.x to 2.1.x - php bin/magento setup:static-content:deploy
  - For Magento version 2.2.x & above - php bin/magento setup:static-content:deploy -f
  - php bin/magento cache:flush

## 2. Configuration

To configure the extension, login to Magento 2 backend, move to **Stores → Configuration → Restrict Fake Registration** where you can find various settings to configure the extension.

- **Restrict Fake Registration:** Enable the Restrict Fake Registration extension.
- **Restricted Email Domains:** Enter comma separated Email domains (TLDs to restrict fake registration from them).
- **First Name Character Limit:** Enter the maximum character limit for first name to restrict registration.
- **Last Name Character Limit:** Enter the maximum character limit for last name.

**Restricted Email Domains** [store view] demo.de,admin.me,fru.re **Enter comma separated domains to restrict fake registration**

**First Name Character Limit** [store view] 10 **Enter maximum character limit for first name**  
Specify maximum character limit of the first name to allow registration.


**Last Name Character Limit** [store view] 10 **Enter maximum character limit for last name**  
Specify maximum character limit of the last name to allow registration.

### 3. Google reCAPTCHA Settings

Enable [Google reCAPTCHA v3](#) to avoid spam and bots from registering to your Magento 2 store.

- **Google reCAPTCHA:** Enable Google reCAPTCHA to provide security against registration from spams.
- **Site Key:** Enter the site key you got while registration with Google reCAPTCHA v3.
- **Secret Key:** Enter the secret key you got while registration with Google reCAPTCHA v3.

### 4. Fake Registration Validation Message


After the successful extension configuration, whenever users try to register using the restricted Email domains or make use of first name and last name exceeding the character limits, a restriction message is displayed on the frontend. Also, Google reCAPTCHA v3 is enabled on the registration form for security from spam registrations.
