

Install with Magento 2 Component Manager

If you purchased our extension on the Magento Marketplace, you can install the extension with the Component Manager. The installation process for this extension similar to any other extensions on the Magento Marketplace.

Enabling Extension:

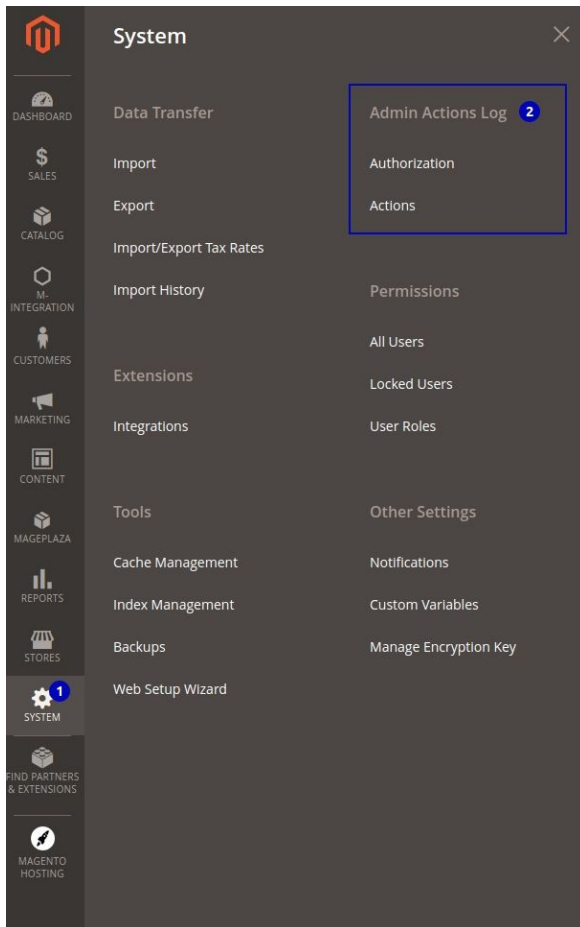
To enable extension go to Stores->Configurations->Advanced->Admin, Change “Enable Admin Actions Logging” to “Yes” and click “Save Config” button. After this your extension is on.
