

miniOrange OTP Verification Extension

Installation Steps -

1. Download the OTP Verification extension zip.
2. Go to your Magento root directory.
3. Unzip all contents of the zip inside the app/code directory.
4. Run the following command on command prompt to enable the module: `php bin/magento setup:upgrade`.
5. Compile the setup using command: `php bin/magento setup:di:compile`.
6. Log in to Magento2 backend to see the active extension.

Configure OTP Extension -

1. In the extension go to the settings tab where you can select your configuration method from the options.
