


# Accessibly App User Guide For Magento

## Set-Up

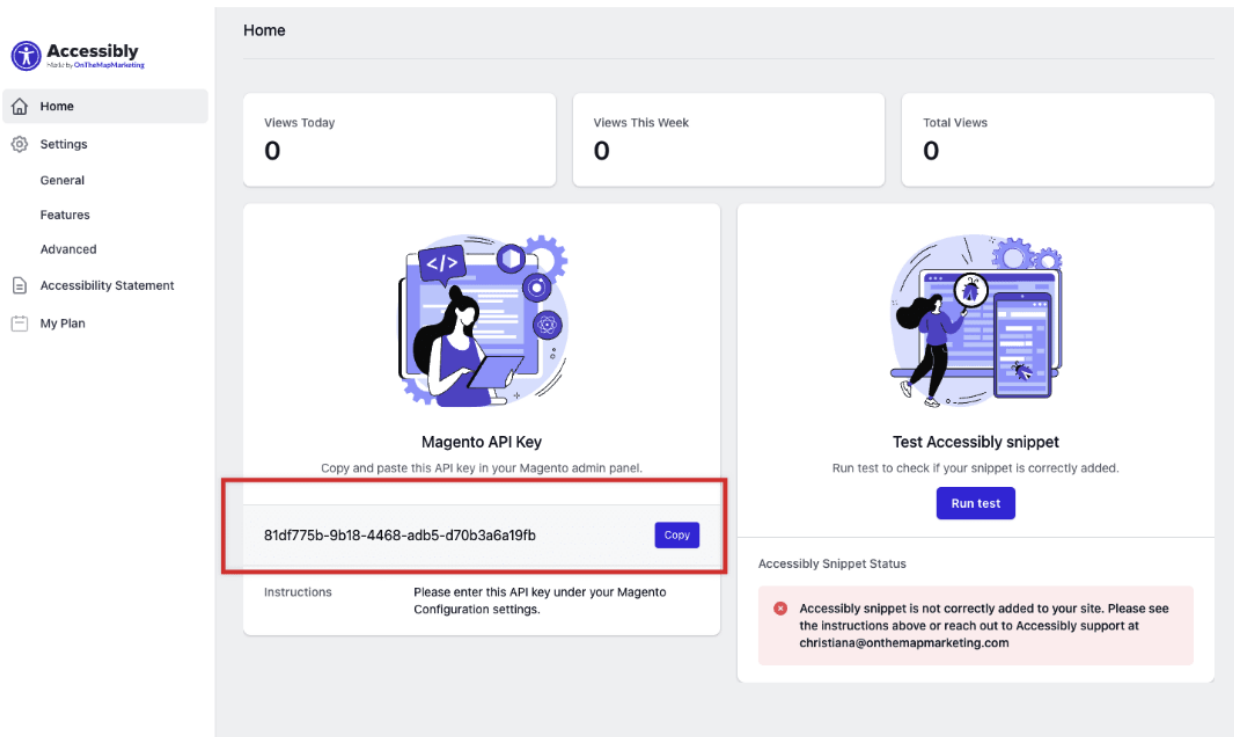
Once you log into your site's Magento dashboard, please head over to Stores → Configuration. Here, you will be presented with a view where an API key from the Accessibly Standalone app must be added:
