

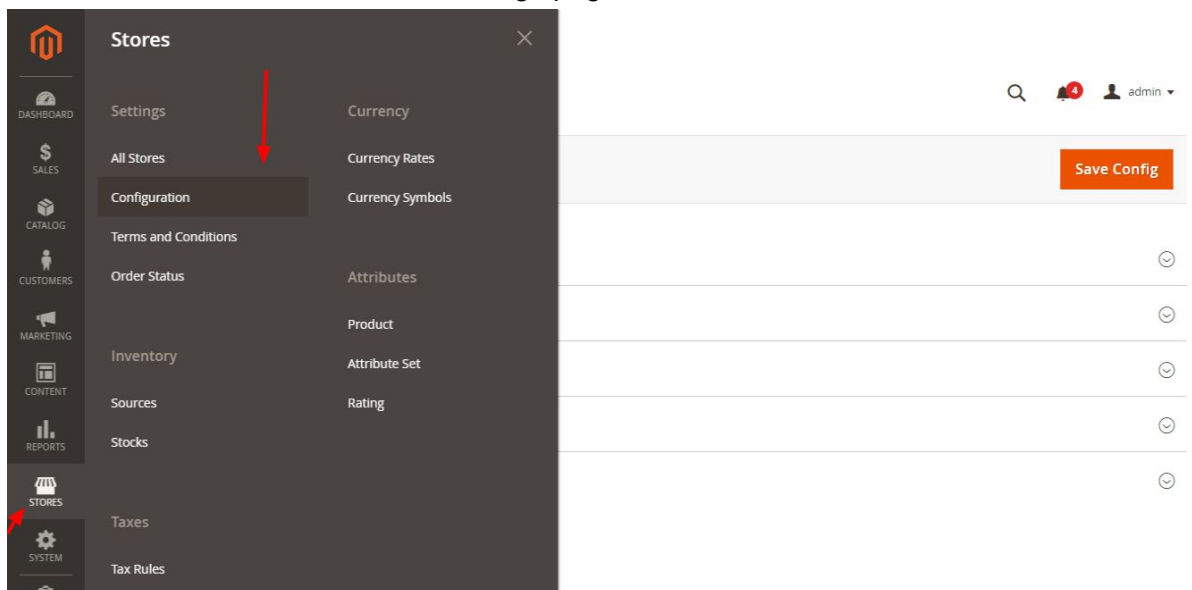
Connect OptiPic for Magento 2

OptiPic for Magento 2 is a free tool that connects your Magento 2 site with [OptiPic CDN](#) service to optimize site images and smart convert it to WebP format on the fly.












How to connect

1. Download and install this OptiPic extension for Magento 2.
2. [Register](#) your account on OptiPic.io site.
3. Add your site on the [OptiPic CDN Control Panel](#).
4. Get your site **ID** from OptiPic CDN Control Panel sites list.
5. Copy your site **ID** to the settings page of this OptiPic extension on your Magento admin area.
6. Add your site domain to the field “**Domain list**” on the extension settings page.
7. Add other settings on the extension settings page if you need.
