


Product Labels For Magento Installation/Configuration Guide

Installation

1. First of all, back up your store database and web directory. It is wise to perform this procedure before any installation.
2. On your back end, go to **System** → **Magento Connect** → **Magento Connect Manager** and log in to Magento Connect Manager with administrator credentials.
3. Under “Direct package file upload” section, browse for package file and hit “Upload”.

Adding Labels from Product Edit Page

You can add custom product label to any product manually from the product editing page:

Adding Labels with Rules

You can apply labels to bunch of products using rules. It is similar to catalog price rules. Go to **Promotions** → **Product Label Rules** and create new rule using “Add New Rule” button.
