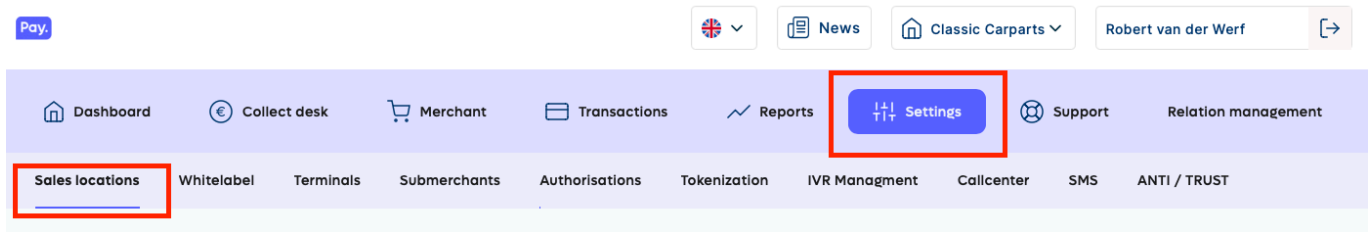

Go to <https://www.pay.nl/en/> and login with your email address and password. In the menu go to "Settings" > "Sales locations"

Enabling payment methods

Enable the checkboxes for each payment method that you want to use. Payment methods that are not enabled here cannot be enabled in Magento.

Other settings

After selecting the payment methods, you can setup “Exchange settings” or also called “Communications URL”. The plugin will work with the standard settings, but when something goes wrong in the communication between Pay. and your webshop, we will not retry.

Exchange settings

The exchange URL is a webservice our system calls when a payment state changes (new_ppt, cancel, delete and several more actions).

The plugin uses the:

- AT-code (account code)
- API token
- SL-code (sales location)

to connect to your Pay. account. To get your credentials, go to "Settings" > "Sales location" and click on "Info".

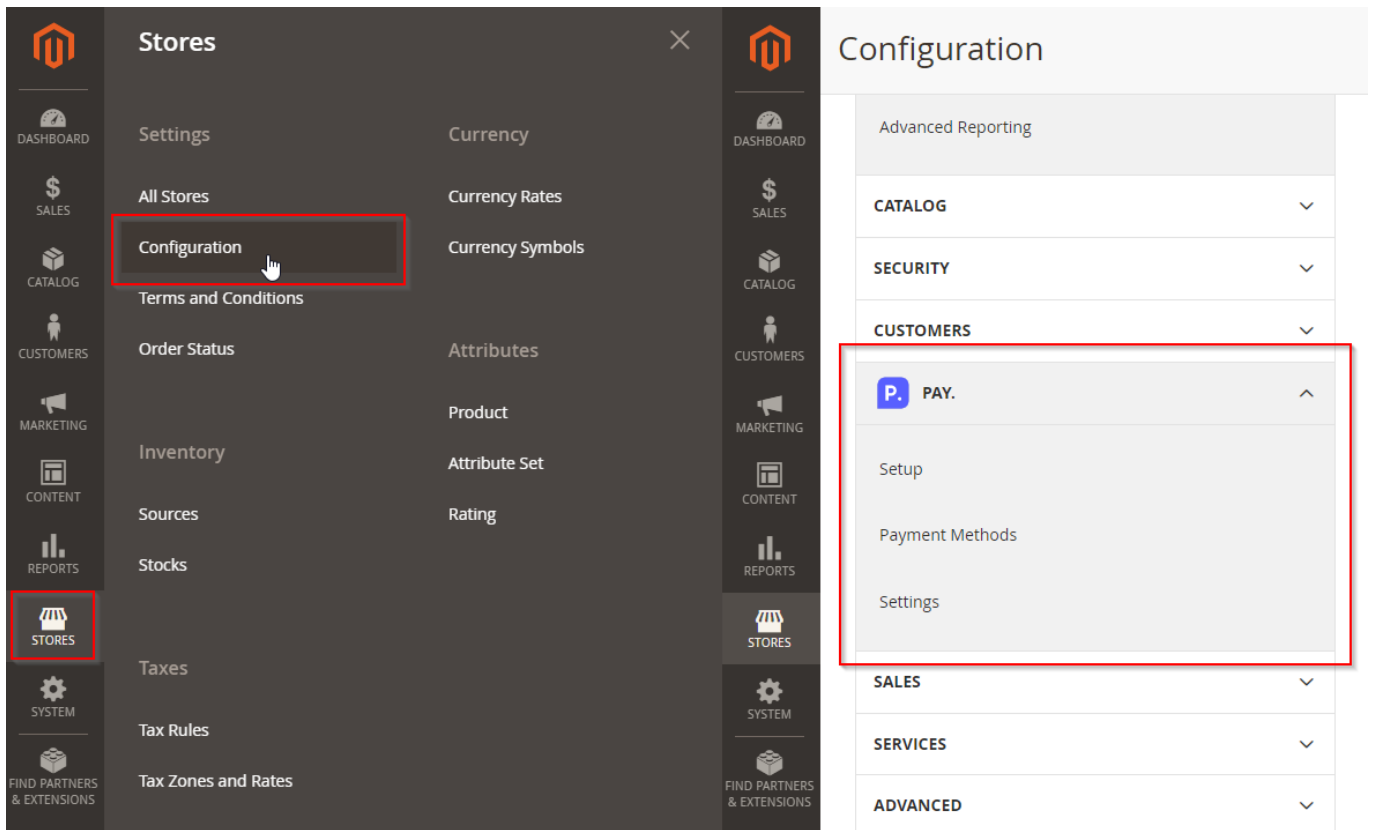

3. In the Magento 2 admin

After you've installed the plugin, it still needs to be configured. On the bottom left, click "Stores" and in the menu click "Configuration". Now go to "Pay."



Configure your credentials (AT-code, API token and SL-code) by going to "Setup" in the Pay. menu. Fill in:

- AT-code in Tokencode
- API token
- SL-code in Serviceld
