



# How to Download, Install & Update FedEx Shipping Rates & Label Magento 2.0 Extension?

This article gives you step-by-step instructions to install Magento 2.0 FedEx Shipping Rates and Label extension.

## Steps to Install the Extension:

1. Get the folder containing the extension
2. Move to **app** folder from Magento root. Create a folder **code** inside the **app**.
3. Copy the extension folder you into the **code** folder.
4. Login to your **SSH**. Navigate to **bin** folder from Magento root.
5. In the terminal, Run

```
./magento module:status
```

. You can see the extension under the list of disabled modules.

./magento module:enable module_name
```

to enable the extension.

to finish installation
