This section will show how to setup a copy of the Google Tag Manager extension for Magento 2. Before reading this section the extension should already be installed.


Configuration

Google Tag Manager extension can be easily configured in your web store. This section will show you how to configure the extension via Magento Admin.

Configuration Settings

Google Tag Manager extension settings are located under the main Pronko Extensions module settings. Navigate to the Magento Admin -> Stores -> Configuration -> Pronko Extensions -> Google Tag Manager section.

Below is an example of the screen with Google Tag Manager configuration settings.



By default, Google Tag Manager feature is enabled. There are no additional configuration is required, however, it can be changed from the Magento Admin.

The following is a table of the settings available for the Enhanced Authorization feature.

Setting	Options	Description
Enable Google Tag Manager	Yes/No (Default: Yes)	Allows to enable or disable the Google Tag Manager functionality.
Container ID	(text)	Google Tag Manager Container ID parameter. Please create an Google Tag Manager Account to get your Container ID at https://tagmanager.google.com/#/hoome
