

## USER GUIDE- STORE LOCATOR

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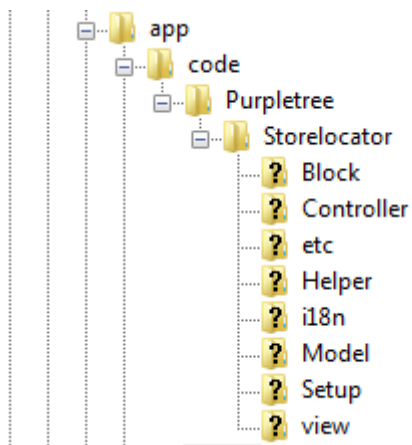
### INSTALLATION

Unpack the zip file inside **app/code/Purpletree/Storelocator/** directory.

Folder Structure of extension in Magento2 would be:

<Magento Root>/app/code/**Purpletree/Storelocator/controller**

<Magento Root>/app/code/**Purpletree/Storelocator/block**



From shell/command prompt, run following commands on Magento root directory:

**php bin/magento setup:upgrade**

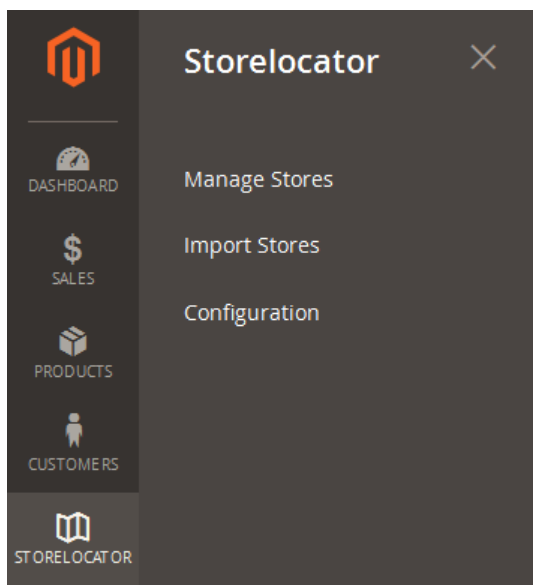
## CONFIGURATION

On successful installation, a new Menu and submenu will appear in magento Admin panel with name of **Storelocator**. It will have three sub menus

- Manage Stores

- Import Stores

- Configuration



To Configure and Enable the Extension

- Go to Storelocator > Configuration.
- In “General Configuration”, Set “Module Enable” to Yes.
- Now Enter License key you get with this extension in License key field. **(required field)**  
If you haven’t received license key, please contact our support team.
- Enter Default Latitude and Default Longitude, which will be the center for store locator map in frontend. Get this from google map.**(required field)**


- Enter Google Api key. Get this from google. **(required field)**
- Create standard Google API Web Service from Google API Console.



## CONFIGURATION DETAILS

### GENERAL CONFIGURATION

- Module Enable – Set it to Yes for Viewing Store locator on Frontend.
- License Key – Purchase this extension from us and we will give your license key. Contact support if you haven't received license yet.
- Page Title – Title of page. Default is set to "Store locator".
- Page Heading – Heading on top of page content. Default is set to "Find Stores Near you".
- Page Sub title – Comes above the listing of stores in left side. Default is set to "List of Stores".
- Page Content – Content on page. Default is blank. Use WYSIWYG Editor.
- Default Latitude – This Latitude will be the center of map.
- Default Longitude - This Latitude will be the center of map.
- Google Api – Get this from google as explained above.

## MANAGE LINKS

- Enable Header link – Header Link for store locator page.
- Header Link Label – Label for Header link. Default is set to “Store Locator”.
- Enable Foote Link – Footer Link for store locator page.
- Footer link label – Label for Footer link shown in menu. Default is set to “Store Locator”.

**Note – The Links on Header and Footer may not appear in Custom theme. Links will be there in default theme of Magento 2.**

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## GOOGLE MAP SETTINGS

- Map Marker – Marker icon to be displayed on google map. Its default icon is marker provided by google maps (For best results Image size should be 40X40).
- Map Zoom – Zoom level of map on load of page. Default is set to 6.
- On Click Map Zoom - Zoom level of map on click of store. Default is set to 6.

### Google map settings

## SEARCH ENGINE OPTIMIZATION

- Url Identifier – url for store locator. Default is set to “storelocator”.
- Url Suffix – Suffix to be attached with url identifier. Default is set to “.html”.
- The default url will be <http://example.com/storelocator.html>
- META Keywords - For SEO of page. Default is set to “Store Locator, Find Stores, Google Stores”.
- META Description - For Seo of page. Default is set to “Find Stores near you with Store Locator.”.

(eg: .html) - (Default - .html)

META Keywords [global]   
Default - Store Locator,Find Stores,Google Stores

META Description. [global]

## MANAGING STORES


Go to *Storelocator > Manage Stores* to add new stores and manage existing stores

- Click on Add New Store Button.
- Add all the detail of the store.
- Status – Set it to Enable for showing on front.
- Show View Page – Single view page for this store. (View Detail Link on storelocator page.)
- Latitude – Latitude location. Get this from google maps.(e.g 28.11234)
- Longitude –Longitude location. Get this from google maps. (e.g 72.5552)

- Store Description – Shown on single view page of this store.
- Image Thumbnail – To be shown on single view page of this store.
- Save this store.

- Refresh your Magento cache, if the store is not visible on frontend after saving(make sure that store is enabled).



## IMPORTING STORES

Go to *Storelocator > Import Stores* to Import list of stores from CSV File.

- Click on Download Sample File or use the Export csv file of stores.
- Store ID Field is to be entered if you want to edit the previously added store.
- Leave blank the Store ID if you want to add new store.
- Do not delete or rename any column name.

### Fields in CSV File:

- Store ID – Leave blank if you are adding new store, else enter store id of any previous store to edit that store details.
- Store Name – Name of the store.
- Country
- City
- State
- Postal Code – zip code
- Address – Full Address of store
- Latitude – get this from google maps
- Longitude – get this from google maps
- Phone – 10 Digit Phone number
- Store Description – Full Description of that store. You can use html tags in this field
- Status – 0 for Disabled and 1 for Enable
- Show View Page – To Show Detailed page on frontend set this to 1 else set this to 0.
