Step 1: Download/purchase the extension

Step 2: Unzip the file inside app/code/Sanjay/Cancelorderemail/ directory


Step 3: php bin/magento setup:upgrade Then run following command

Step 4: php bin/magento setup:static-content:deploy -f

Step 5: php bin/magento indexer:reindex

Step 6: php bin/magento cache:flush

Step 5: After That 'Cancel Order Email' module will be shown in the admin panel inside Store=>Configuration section. Now you can navigate to your Magento 2 admin panel and start configuring your extension.
