

Upon installation of the plugin, a new payment method should be available on the backend. The options are listed below.

The options have the following meaning:

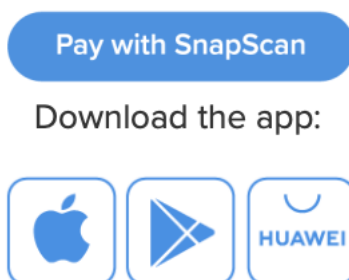
Enabled - Whether or not this plugin will show as an additional payment method

Snapscan Merchante Code - The merchant code received from SnapScan

Snapscan API Key - The API key received from SnapScan to authorize transactions.

Webhook Auth Key - The auth key for using web hooks with SnapScan. Web hooks are used to confirm a transaction even if they do not return to the website to complete the transaction.

Once an order is made, the option to pay via SnapScan should be present. Selecting the option changes based on device. On a mobile device, the following will be displayed:



Upon clicking "Pay with SnapScan", the browser will open SnapScan and initiate the transaction.

On a desktop device, the screen looks as follows:
