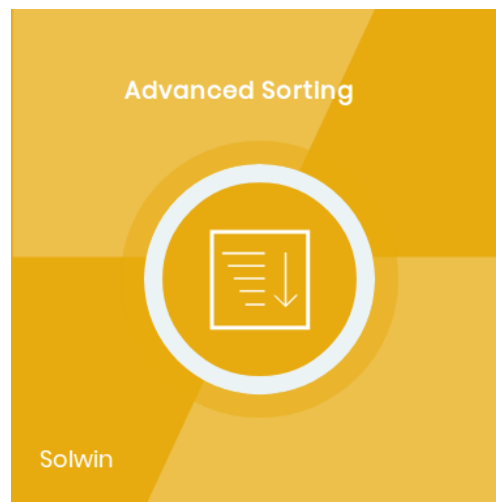


Advanced Sorting



Installation/User Guide

Installation Process:

Note: Please take a backup of your all Magento files and database before installing or updating any extension.

Extension Installation:

- Download the Advanced Sorting .ZIP file from the Magento account.
- Log in to the Magento server (or switch to) as a user, who has permission to write to the Magento file system.
- Create folder structure **/app/code/Solwin/AdvancedSorting/** to your site root directory
- Extract the contents of the .ZIP file to the folder you just created
- Navigate to your store root folder in the SSH console of your server:
- Run upgrade command as specified : **php bin/magento setup:upgrade**
- Run deploy command as specified : **php bin/magento setup:static-content:deploy -f**
- Clear the cache either from the admin panel or command line **php bin/magento cache:clean**
- Now, you can see the Solwin menu in the admin panel. Please go to **Solwin -> Advanced Sorting -> Configuration** and select **Enable** to Yes.
- Change/Set all other options as per your requirements and save settings.

Overview:

Advanced Sorting extension for Magento 2 adds custom sorting options to make products easier to find. This extension gives effective options to customers for product sorting – by bestsellers, most viewed, biggest saving, rating, quantity/stock, and more. Advanced Sorting will give each customer an option to display the products in the sorting order, which suits him or her best.

Ready to use sorting options:

- **Most Viewed** – Most viewed products come first.
- **Best Sellers** – Bestseller products come first.
- **Last Ordered** – Last ordered products come first.
- **Biggest Saving** – Product with the highest discount comes first.
- **Wishlist** – Products in wishlist come first.
- **Rating** – Products with the highest rating come first.
- **Reviews Count** – Products with the highest review come first.
- **Featured** – Featured products that are selected by the admin, those products

should come first.

- **Quantity/Stock** – Products with the Lowest Quantity/Stock come first.
- **Newly Added** – Most new added product comes first by date.
- **New Set** – Newly added product comes first.

Key Features:

Extension provides below features:

- It provides a fully customizable interface of the extension from the easily manageable admin.
- Ability to enable/disable from the admin control panel.
- Store owners can select multiple sort options from the admin control panel.
- Store owner can set default product listing sort by from **Stores -> Settings -> Configuration -> CATALOG -> Catalog -> Storefront -> Product Listing Sort by.**
- Make store more user-friendly to increase profit – more orders for store.

Admin control panel:

In the Configuration tab, this extension allows the store owner to enable or disable the module from the admin control panel. Go to **Solwin >> Advanced Sorting >> Configuration.**

Select multiple sort options to display in sort by dropdown in frontend.
For windows/Linux: Hold down the control (ctrl) button to select multiple options
For Mac: Hold down the command button to select multiple options

- **Enable:** Yes | No.
- **Select Sort Option:** Select sort options that store owners want to display in sort by dropdown on the front side.

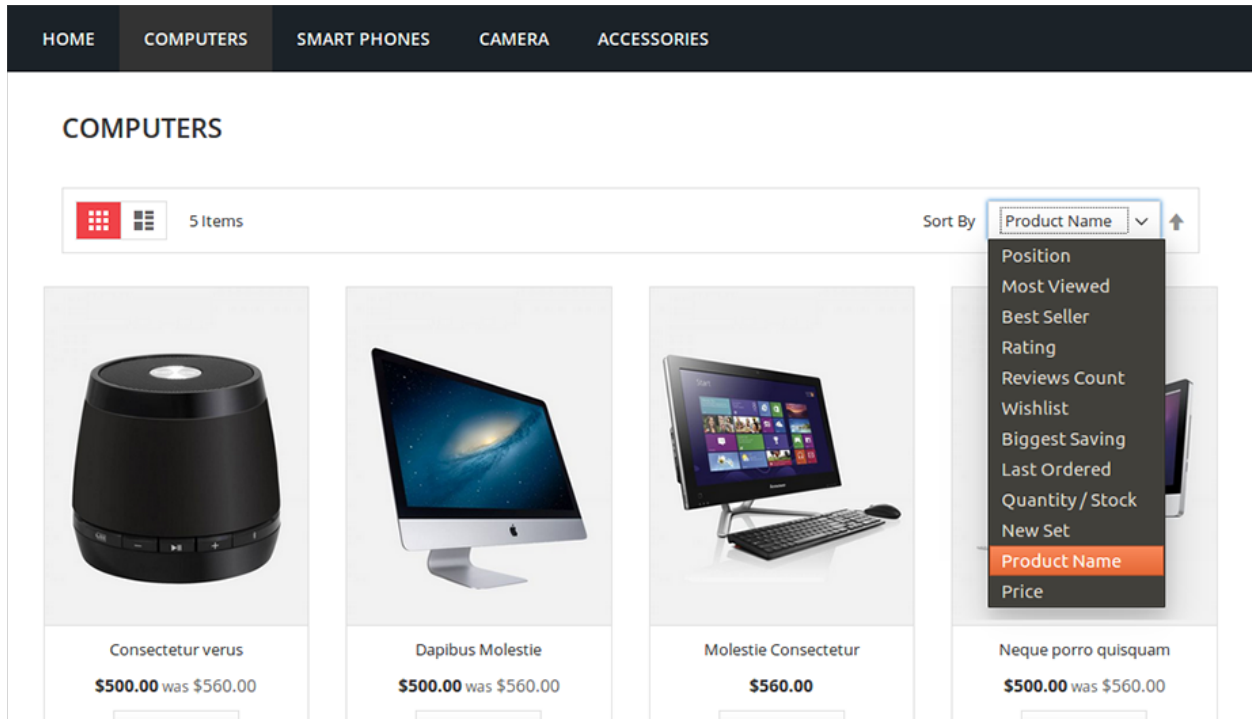
Go to **Stores -> Settings -> Configuration -> CATALOG -> Catalog -> Storefront** and select default sort option from **Product Listing Sort by**.
