Welcome to Testimonials Extension for Magento 2 developed by Sparsh.


We have provided this guide to understand better use of the extension. We have tried to explain the basic functionality required by every Magento store.

This extension is used to add trustworthy testimonials to your webpage feedback which consists of info about the author and so gain the user's trust and credibility.

Every below steps helps to show testimonials on your site

1. HOW TO ADD NEW TESTIMONIALS FROM ADMIN

Go to [Magento 2 Admin] > Login > Testimonials > Manage Testimonials > Add New Testimonial

Fill the form details to create a new testimonial:

- **Name:** Name of Client or Customer. Required.
- **Message:** Testimonial Message of Client or Customer. Required.
- **Address:** Address / location of client. Optional.
- **Publish Date:** Publish date of testimonial. Required.
- **Status:** Admin can set testimonial status as enabled or disabled according to requirements. Required is enabled.
- **SortOrder:** Admin can set order of testimonials to be displayed. It will be displayed in descending order. Default is 0.
- **Show on home page:** Admin can set testimonial on home page as yes or no according to requirements. Default is no.

2. MANAGE TESTIMONIALS DETAILS

Go to [Magento 2 Admin] > Login > Testimonials > Manage Testimonials.

You can find all testimonials added from frontend / backend here. Testimonial grid has details like Message, Client Name, Address, Position, Publish Date, Show on Homepage, Status etc... of all testimonials of the website.



3. HOW TO ADD TESTIMONIAL WIDGET FOR GIVEN CMS PAGE

Go to [Magento 2 Admin] > Login > Content > Elements > Pages > Add / Edit Page

Open “Content” > Click on “Show / Hide Editor” button > Click on “Insert Widget” button



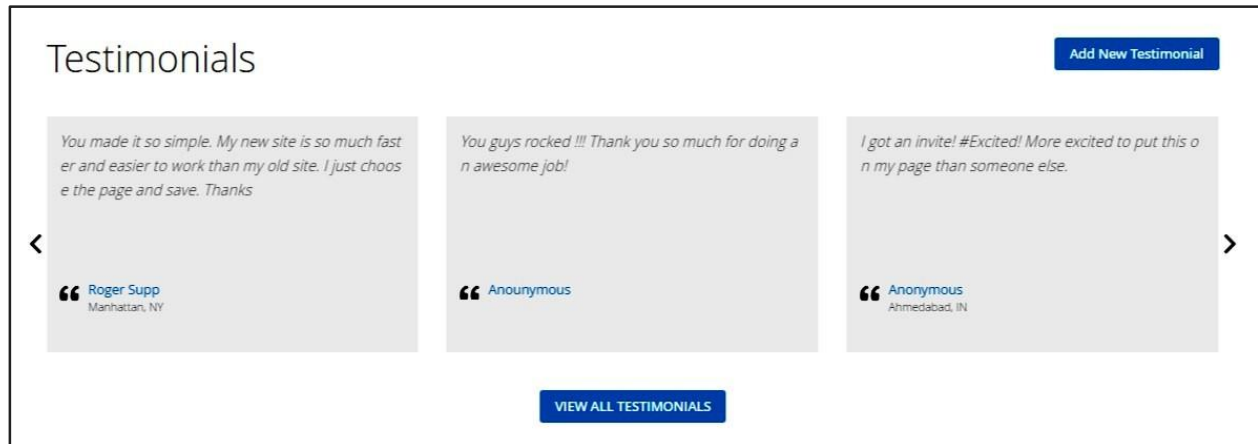
Choose Widget Type as “Testimonials” > Click on “Insert Widget” button

Showing your Testimonials like below on storefront.






5. HOW VISITOR CAN ADD NEW TESTIMONIAL FROM STOREFRONT


