

# LOGIN WITH MOBILE NUMBER

## USER GUIDE

*Version 1.0.0*

Welcome to Login With Mobile Number Extension for Magento 2 developed by Sparsh.

This extension provides an option for the customer to log in using a mobile number or email address.

### KEY FEATURES:

- ❖ Allow customers to log in using their email, phone number or both
- ❖ Mobile number login can be enabled or disabled from the admin panel
- ❖ Allows to save a mobile number while registration
- ❖ Allows to login using a mobile number, email or any
- ❖ The mobile number will be unique for each customer
- ❖ Allows customers to change their registered mobile number from their "My Account" section
- ❖ Validate mobile number length based on the country
- ❖ Allows the admin to view and update the mobile number of any customer
- ❖ Customers can even log in to their accounts using their email or mobile number at checkout

### 1. ENABLE LOGIN WITH MOBILE NUMBER EXTENSION

To use this extension, you first need to enable it from the backend.

Go to Magento 2 Admin > Login > Stores > Configuration > Sparsh Extensions > Login With Mobile Number.

Expand the **General Configurations** section, and do the following:

- **Enable:** Select "Yes" to enable this extension.
- **Login Mode:** You can choose to "Login with either email or mobile" or "Login with mobile only"

Clear cache from System > Tools > Cache Management if required.

## 2. MOBILE NUMBER OPTION ON THE REGISTRATION PAGE

Once enabled, you will get a field to enter the mobile number too on the registration page.

You will need to choose the country and enter the mobile number without the country code.

The Mobile number must be unique to each customer.





#### 4. OPTION TO UPDATE MOBILE NUMBER ON THE CUSTOMER MY ACCOUNT PAGE
