


Product Preview & Publish

There's a reason why WYSIWYG editors are still around. The administrators would like to see how their content is going to look like before they publish them on the website. Many of my customers have been asking for this sort of functionality in Magento2 as well. Because the content is supposed to be published on many different platform and devices, hence it is better to preview all the changes before publishing it.

Preview Product

This extension allows the administrator to preview product changes on the frontend website even if the product is "Disabled" and/or set to "Not Visible Individually".


A preview button has been added on the product grid action column through which the administrator can select the product and click on the link to preview the product.
