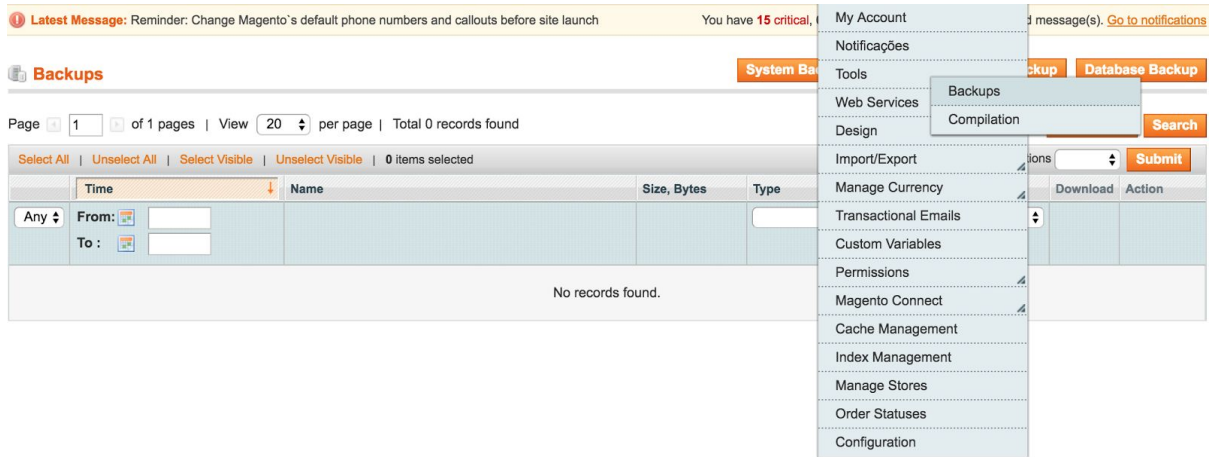

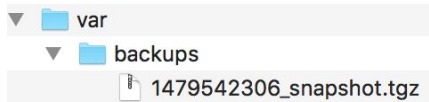
# Preparing for Installation

## Backup (Optional)

1. In the Admin, go to System > Tools > Backups;
2. Select one of the 3 options.



3. You can also use other tools such as mysqldump (via the command line) or phpmyadmin to take a backup of your database. If you use phpmyadmin, be sure to tick the “Disable Foreign Key Constraints” box to be able to properly restore the backup. Depending on your database size and server speed, this may take a while. Once the backup is finished, you will find the zipped backup under var/backups:



## Disable Compilation

In the Admin, go to System > Tools > Compilation and disable compilation.

## Disable all Magento Caches

1. In the Admin, go to System > Cache Management;
2. Click “Select all” at the top of the grid;
3. In “Actions” select “Disable”;
4. Click the submit button.

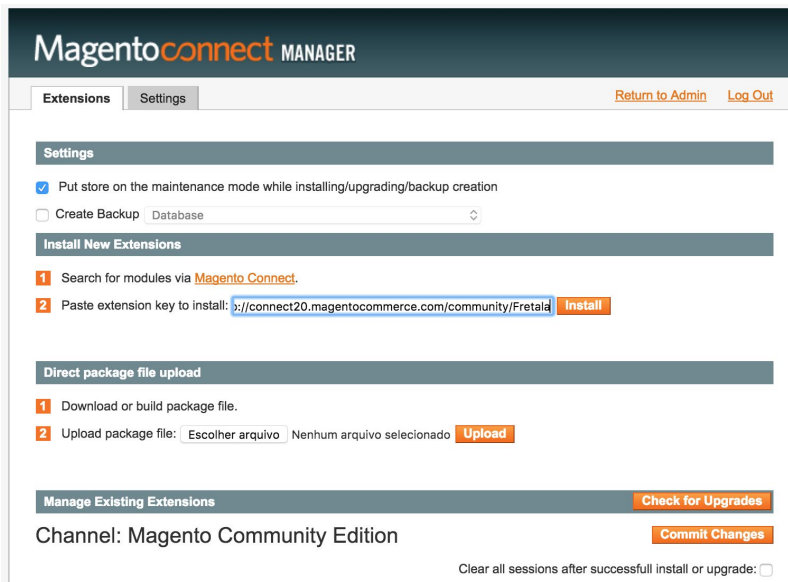
## Installation via Magento Connect

**NOTE:** This approach is no longer recommended unless you are installing in a local environment or have taken all security measures while always keeping your Magento up-to-date with all patches.

1. In Magento Connect extension page, select and copy the Key:



2. In your Admin Store, go to System > Magento Connect > Magento Connect Manager;
3. Paste the extension key and click the install button:



4. Click the proceed button:

## Installation via Magento Marketplace

## Installation via Package Download Strategy

1. In Magento Connect extension page, select and copy the Key:



2. Go to site: <http://freegento.com/ddl-magento-extension.php>
3. Paste the extension key and download the package.
4. You can install the files by uploading them to your root or via Magento Connect Manager:
  - a. **Magento Connect Manager**
    - i. In your Admin Store, go to System > Magento Connect > Magento Connect Manager;
    - ii. Click the select file button and the upload button.
  - b. **Upload files to your root folder**
    - i. Unzip the downloaded file;
    - ii. Access the unzipped folder;
    - iii. Copy all content (ignore the package.xml file);
    - iv. Paste all content in the your Magento root folder.
