

Vesta Guarantee Magento 2 Extension

Installation and User Guide

Installation

There are two recommended methods for installing the Vesta Guarantee Magento extension:

1. Decompress the extension archive and place the files in the appropriate file structure within your Magento installation

Step 1.

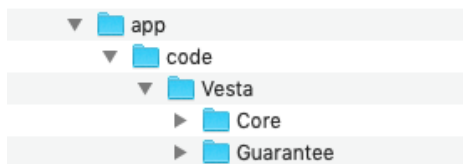
Download and Unzip the Vesta Guarantee Magento extension package.

Step 2.

cd <your Magento install dir>/app/code directory. If the <your Magento install dir>/app/code directory does not exist, then create the app/code directory.

Step 3.

Copy the unzipped 'Vesta' folder and paste it inside the <your Magento install dir>/app/code/directory.



Step 4.

cd <your Magento install dir> and run the following commands:

- a. php bin/magento setup:upgrade
- b. php bin/magento setup:static-content:deploy -f
- c. php bin/magento cache:clean

2. Use the Composer package manager to define the Vesta Guarantee Magento extension as a dependency in your project.

Step 1.

Download and Unzip the Vesta Guarantee Magento extension package.

Step 2.

cd <your Magento install dir> and run the following commands:

- a. `composer require vesta/module-core vesta/module-guarantee`
- b. `composer update`
- c. `php bin/magento setup:upgrade`
- d. `php bin/magento setup:static-content:deploy -f`
- e. `php bin/magento cache:clean`

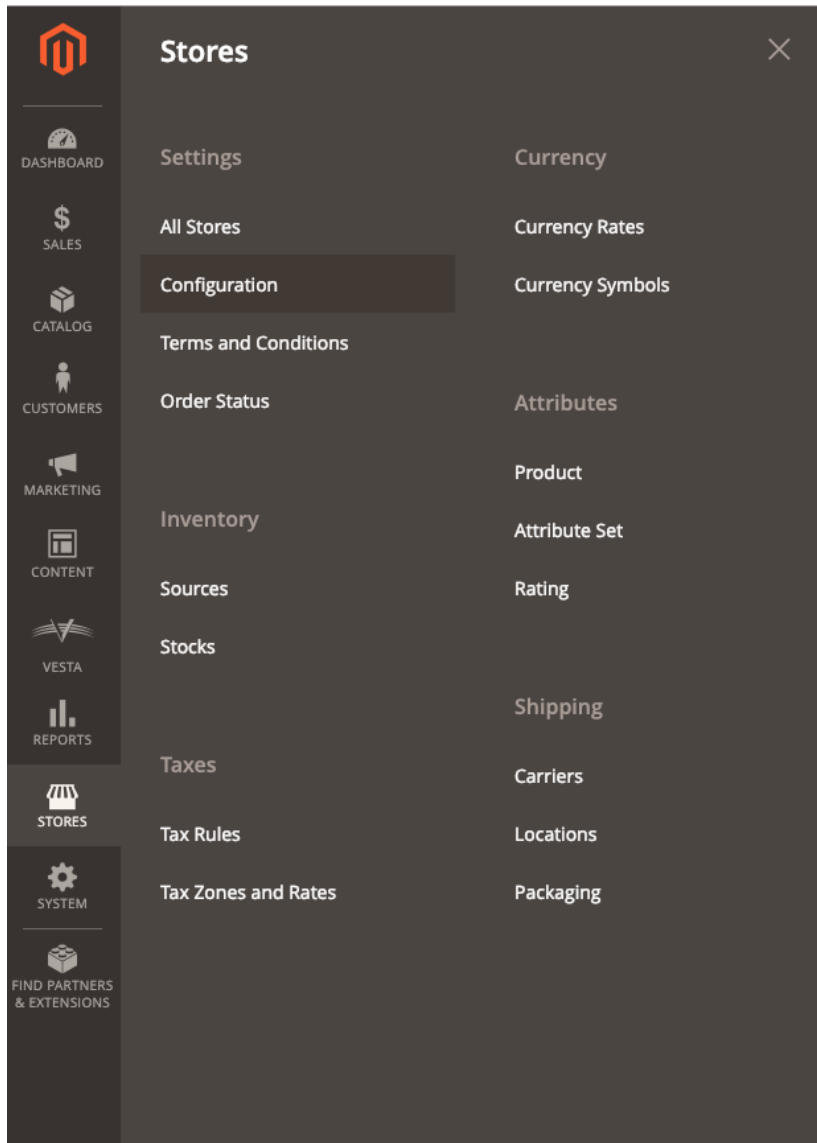
Setup

Activating Vesta Guarantee can be completed in a few seconds, once a contract has been signed and you've received your configuration values from our Service Delivery team.

Note: Before Vesta can promote your solution into a production environment, our Service Delivery team needs to certify your integration.

Step 1.

In your Magento Admin Panel, go to Stores > Configuration > Vesta Guarantee > Configuration.



Step 2.

Under Configuration, do the following:

- In the **Module Enable** dropdown, select **Yes**.
- In the **Account Name**, **Password**, **Guarantee API End Point URL**, **MerchantRoutingID**, **Partner Customer Key**, **Auto Disposition** and **Acquirer CD** fields, enter the values provided to you by our Service Delivery team.
