Improved Product Sorting

The 'Improved Product Sorting' extension adds custom sorting options to make products easier for the customers to find. This extension gives effective options for sorting products – in the order of newest, most viewed, rating, and more.

More often than not, clients require a really flexible product sorting tool to find the exact products they are looking for. The default Magento version includes only the 'Sort by Position' (set for the category) and its by attributes. These criteria would not be enough to let users find the products they want. The more criteria for search users see, the more confident they will feel and the better their experience at your store. Improve user experience and let your customers enjoy effortless product sorting!

The 'Advanced Sorting' option will give customers a choice to display the products in a sorting order which is best suited to them. This extension allows sorting products by the following criteria:

- New - Newly added products are displayed first
- Most Viewed - Most viewed products get featured first
- Last Ordered - Last ordered products are displayed first
- Rating - Products with the most ratings are featured first
- Reviews Count - Products with the most number of reviews get displayed first

Features

- Provides a fully customizable, easy to manage interface of the extension from the admin
- Ability to enable/disable from the backend
- The store owner can select multiple sort options from the backend
- The store owner can set default product listing sort by from **Stores -> Configuration -> Catalog -> Storefront**
- Makes your store extra user-friendly, which implies more orders and increased profits for you

In the frontend, customers will be able to view different 'sort by' options as dropdowns in the product list pages as in the below sample :



How to Configure

To configure the extension, go to the backend menu: **Stores -> Configuration**. You will find the entry, **Virtina Extensions -> Product Sorting**. After clicking on it, you get to see a drop-down box where you can enable/disable the module. You will then need to save the configurations and clear the cache.
