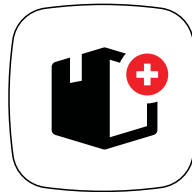

Functional Capabilities

This module is intended to upload files and attach them to any product page or CMS page. Attach content files, such as product manuals, user guides, images, presentations, videos to provide the best customer experience.

Installation

Install the module by following the installation guide.

Adding an Attachment to a Product Page

After installing the module, the administrator must go to

WEB4PRO › Attachments

There, the administrator will see the following page.
